The Advent season (the 4 weeks prior to Christmas) will begin November 30! we invite you to join us in an Advent study, corresponding to our weekend worship series.

Christmas Store: Volunteer Opportunities Still Available!

Christmas Store is one of our biggest signature events of the year. This is an event in which 30-40 families who are going through some difficult times are invited to a Christmas event in which they enjoy a wonderful breakfast, get a family portrait taken, shop for amazing items for their children at a fraction of retail, and have a chance to meet for prayer with our pastor and Congregational Care Coordinator. Preparations for this year's Christmas Store on Saturday, December 6th are in full swing. If you still hope to be a part of this magical event, there is still time to volunteer. We are looking for a few more people to help in just a few areas:

- <u>Building Prep</u>: Help to clear the children's area on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 2nd</u>, <u>starting at 2pm</u>. This involves moving furniture to empty the spaces that will be used for the store. See Al if you have guestions.
- <u>Floaters/Car Loaders</u>: On Christmas Store Day, Saturday, Dec. 6th, take one of two
 volunteer shifts, one from 8-11am or 11am-2pm. Your main duties would be to load the
 wrapped Christmas presents into the cars along with being present to help keep things running
 smoothly.
- <u>Clean Up</u>: This volunteer position starts at around 2:30pm on Saturday, Dec 6th. We need help boxing the remaining toys and items and moving those boxes into the waiting trucks and trailers to be stored for next year. Help is also needed to clean and reset the sanctuary and return furniture to the children's area.
- <u>Toy Hauler:</u> Help transport toys! Two shifts, one getting toys TO the church in preparation for the Christmas store, and one to transport toys FROM the church, after the completion of Christmas store. On **Wednesday, Dec 3rd, at 6 p.m. transport toys** from the storage location in Jackson to the church. If you have a truck or other large vehicle, that would be great! And/Or On **Saturday, Dec. 6, at 3 pm transport toys** and decorations from the church to the storage location in Jackson.

Our **Christmas Store on December 6** is gearing up! The team that is going to prepare breakfast for the families would appreciate food donations. Here's what we need:

Also needed are: 3 gallons of milk, 5 orange juice (64 oz bottles), 4 apple juice (64 oz bottles, 36 cheese sticks, 25 6-oz cups, 2 doz. hard boiled eggs, peeled, 20 single serve boxes of cereal, 3 Bags of Cuties (oranges), 3 Bags of small apples, 36 Envelopes of Hot Chocolate Mix, 4 cases of small water bottles (for kids area), 10 boxes of granola bars, 1 box of instant oatmeal.
