How to be a "Trunk" for Trunk-or-Treat

Please sign up on the website (scan QR code below). Decorate your trunk using family-friendly decorations. Please do not use decorations that are highly frightening to young children. Hand out candy to the kids! Compliment costumes! Meet new friends! Have fun! We encourage participants to wear costumes, but adults should not wear costume masks. For security purposes all adults must be identifiable. (Protective masks for health care purposes are permitted.) Bring lawn chairs to sit in while handing out treats to the kids. Bring your favorite snacks or non-alcoholic beverages. This is a rain-or-shine event.

In the event of rain, activities will be moved indoors.



ABOUT THE TREATS:

- Provide individually wrapped, store-bought treats.
- Consider candy, as well as non-food options such as bubbles or other small prizes. Please do not give out toy weapons such as toy knives or guns.
- Consider dye-free, nut-free and gluten-free choices.

ABOUT THE VEHICLES:

- Trunk- or-Treat will be held in the side parking lot at Still Waters Church.
- Decorated vehicles may enter the side parking lot between 12:00 12:30pm.
- * For safety purposes, the side parking lot will be barricaded at 2:30pm. No additional vehicles will enter.
- Use one parking space per decorated vehicle.
- Vehicle engines must be turned off for the duration of the event.
- If lights are needed, please use battery powered lights. Electricity will not be available on site.
- No open flames, fireworks or highly flammable materials may be used.
- For safety purposes, decorated cars will not be allowed to leave the side parking lot until 8:30pm. If the times do not work for you, we would love to have you volunteer in some other capacity.

Trunk- or-Treat is an event where volunteers decorate the trunks of their cars and fill them with treats for the children. The children walk by the cars and receive a treat at each decorated car. It is a great time for the children to enjoy the evening and not feel frightened about trick or treating, and it is a great opportunity to introduce families to our church
