Manitoba Incentive Program Purse Supplements 2024:

To qualify for purse supplements:

- Purse supplements are paid out on class levels to Manitoba-breds and Saskatchewan-breds for their racing lifetime
 - Must be foaled in Manitoba or Saskatchewan, have Canadian papers and meet class level criteria

Purse supplements are not paid on: Stake races, Manitoba restricted claiming races, Manitoba restricted allowance races.

- Horse must be bred by a Manitoba or Saskatchewan resident, be foaled in Manitoba or Saskatchewan and have Canadian papers
 - For All Classes paid to horses during the lifetime of their racing career
- Non-residents of Manitoba and Saskatchewan can be eligible for Breeder Awards if the foal is born in Manitoba or Saskatchewan and sired by a stallion from the Manitoba/Saskatchewan Stallion Program in the year of conception.
 - To obtain Breeder/Stallion Awards you must be a CTHS member in the year the awards are earned

THE CTHS BOARD REVIEWS THE MANITOBA INCENTIVE PROGRAM MONTHLY AND ADJUSTMENTS MAY BE MADE ACCORDINGLY. All purses and supplements are contingent on funding.
