The CTHS MB, HBPA AND MJC introduced a new monthly program in 2022 that recognizes performances by MB Breds and their respective Trainers. Each time that a MB bred runs, points are awarded on 1st to 5th basis regardless of the Class or Purse of the race.

2 Yr. Old Canadian-bred, ON, MB, AB, + Manitoba Sired 3 Yr.Old Colt/Gelding & B.C. CTHS Sale Graduates (# ON, AB, & B.C. sale grads must pay a \$750 nomination fee, \$750 to enter and \$1,000 +*Manitoba Sired 3 Yr. Old Fillies to start.

- #ON, AB & B.C. nominations for the MB Sales Stake are due August 2nd, 2024 through the Bookkeepers Office
- 1st nomination is due the year the foal is born
- +Sired by accredited Manitoba and Saskatchewan stallions registered into the Sires Program

Manitoba Incentive Program Purse Supplements 2024: To qualify for purse supplements:

- Purse supplements are paid out on class levels to Manitoba-breds and Saskatchewan-breds for their racing lifetime
 - Must be foaled in Manitoba or Saskatchewan, have Canadian papers and meet class level criteria

Purse supplements are not paid on: Stake races, Manitoba restricted claiming races, Manitoba restricted allowance races.

- Horse must be bred by a Manitoba or Saskatchewan resident, be foaled in Manitoba or Saskatchewan and have Canadian papers
 - For All Classes paid to horses during the lifetime of their racing career
- Non-residents of Manitoba and Saskatchewan can be eligible for Breeder Awards if the foal is born in Manitoba or Saskatchewan and sired by a stallion from the Manitoba/Saskatchewan Stallion Program in the year of conception.
 - To obtain Breeder/Stallion Awards you must be a CTHS member in the year the awards are earned

THE CTHS BOARD REVIEWS THE MANITOBA INCENTIVE PROGRAM MONTHLY AND ADJUSTMENTS MAY BE MADE ACCORDINGLY. All purses and supplements are contingent on funding.

Shipping Incentive Program

The CTHS MB Division is renewing their 2022/2023/2024 Shipping Incentive Program effective immediately until further notice with a few revisions.

The objective of the program is to increase the foal and stallion population.

The CTHS MB Division will pay a maximum of \$2,000.00 to ship-in a mare in foal and/or a stallion. The following conditions have to be met:

- ⇒ Mare infoal and/or stallion must be purchased through a bonafide sale and/or private sale as long as there is a bill of sale issued
- ⇒ Leased stallions are also eligible if there is a completed Stallion Lease Agreement
- ⇒ The mare must be purchased for breeding purposes only—not racing and we will require the applicant's signature on a CTHS MB document stating same
- ⇒ Includes open mares for breeding purposes
- ⇒ Mare be bred confirmation from the stallion owner
- ⇒ Applicant must be a member of the CTHS MB Division
- ⇒ Shipping fees must be supported by a Bill of Sale and transfer of ownership
- ⇒ Provide a shipping fee invoice
- ⇒ Payment will be in Canadian funds
- ⇒ Purchaser is responsible for paying the shipper and then presenting the paid invoice to the CTHS MB office for the refund
- ⇒ This incentive program will be capped at \$24,000.00.

The CTHS Board will review this incentive program monthly and adjustments may be made accordingly.

MJC and MB CTHS - MB/SK Registered Foal Program

This program will be offered in 2024 and 2025.

MB/SK breeders with in-foal mares that have not foaled in MB/SK in 2022 and 2023 will be eligible for up to \$4,000. The breeder of the resulting foal will be paid \$3,000 upon registration of the MB/SK foal with The Jockey Club and CTHS National office. Should that same mare produce an MB/SK bred foal by a stallion registered in the MB/SK program in 2025, the breeder will be eligible for a further \$1,000 when the resulting foal is also registered. An extension to the bred back program can be requested by applying to the MB CTHS office by July 1st.

All foals from this program will have their registration certificates assigned to the MB CTHS until the yearlings are either sold through a MB/SK sale or raced at ASD. Horses not entered or sold in a MB/SK sale will have their registration certificates held by the ASD race office until the end of the horses two-year-old's race meet at ASD. Two-year-olds may ship to other tracks prior to completion of the ASD meet for a stakes race with approval from the race office and ASD. Registration papers must be returned to ASD after the stakes race if the ASD meet is ongoing. Repayment of program funds will release the registration certificates at any time.

Mares must be registered, and application approved by the MB CTHS office prior to foaling. The deadline for approval to this program for 2024 is June 1st, 2024. Each mare is only eligible once for this program. A maximum of 30 mares will be accepted into the program. Members may submit more than 1 mare application to the program, but each individual CTHS member will have priority over any member's second mare application. Application priority will be based on the date received by the MB CTHS office. If the program is oversubscribed the CTHS and MJC will allow the extra applications to be first in line, the following year waiving the no foal in MB/SK in 2022-2023 stipulation if they qualify at time of application.

All applicants must be CTHS full members in good standing to be approved into the program. This program cannot be combined with the CTHS Shipping Incentive Program. The CTHS reserves the right to deny any application it deems not in the best interest of CTHS.
