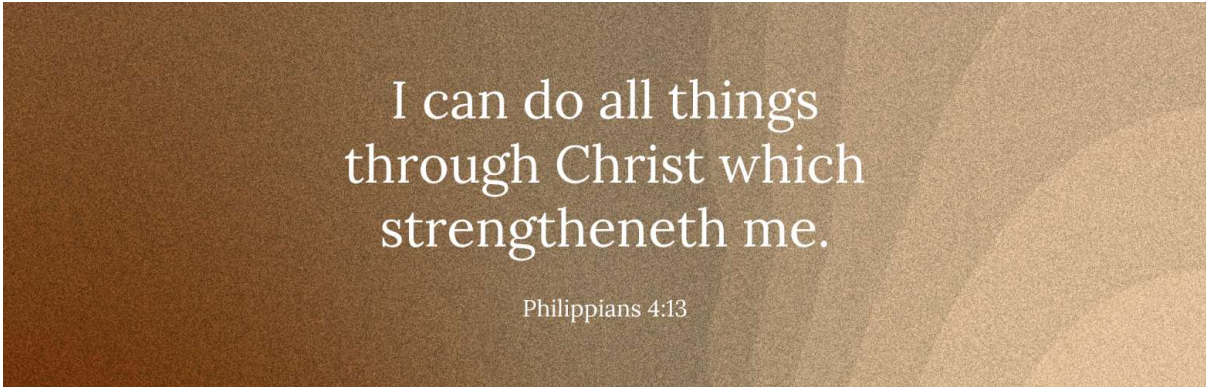

Smartwatches

We have noticed an increase in the number of students who have smartwatches, which have the capabilities of playing games and taking photos.
