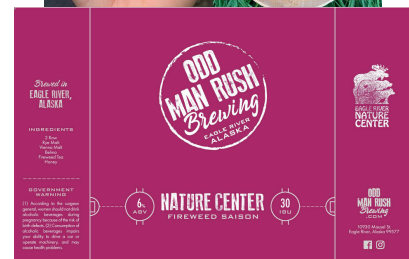

CALL FOR FIREWEED!

- Be sure you are harvesting in an area where it's allowed!
- Only harvest the blooms; don't pull up the whole plant (and don't harvest all the blooms from one plant).
- Bring blooms in a plastic zip lock bag to Odd Man Rushing Brewing in Eagle River by 8/31/2025.
