<b>Organizer:</b>	Wiener Ruderclub Pirat
<b>Venue:</b>	Vienna – Old Danube
<b>Race day:</b>	Saturday, 09 May 2026
<b>Start:</b>	multiple races starting at 9:30 a.m.
<b>Registration deadline:</b>	29 April 2026
<b>Race Categories:</b>	Mixed (crew: 8–10 paddlers + 1 drummer; at least 4 women) Women's (crew: 8–10 female paddlers + 1 drummer) Open (crew: 8–10 paddlers + 1 drummer)
<b>Participants:</b>	Each participant takes part at their own risk and confirms that they are able to swim 100 meters in the clothing they are wearing. The minimum age is 14 years.
<b>Timing:</b>	GPS timing (trac trac)
<b>Distance:</b>	4,800 meters
<b>Entry fee:</b>	180€
<b>Equipment provided:</b>	Boats (Junior Dragon Boat), paddles and steerspersons/helms Using your own steersperson is permitted by arrangement with race management. The use of communication systems in the boat is permitted.
<b>Captains' Meeting</b>	09 May 2026, 9:00 a.m.
<b>Awards Ceremony:</b>	The awards ceremony will take place from 17:30 at WRC Pirat, followed by the party.
<b>Categories scored:</b>	Mixed, Open, Women's (minimum 3 entries)  If the dragon boat race cannot start due to safety-related reasons, there is no entitlement to a full refund of the entry fee. This decision will be made exclusively by race management together with the organizer. The registration must be submitted by April 29, 2026 by email.
<b>Team limit:</b>	20 teams To ensure the event runs smoothly, the number of teams is limited to 20.
