A. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF (non-declinable) \$2,495 This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fe e is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Our charge includes, but is not limited to, staff, facilities, and vehicles to respond to initial requests for service 24 hours every day, consultation with the survivors, coordinating service plans with the cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased, procuring death certificates and permits, consultation and assistance with procuring various death benefits, accounting and billing, regulatory compliance, legal and audit fees, postage, printing and supplies, telephones, insurance, salaries and benefits for our staff, and various county, state, and federal taxes and fees.

B. USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF FOR FUNERAL CEREMONY OR MEMORIAL SERVICE

Staff, facilities, and equipment necessary for conducting services desired OR, if facilities are not used, the additional time, staff, and equipment necessary for conducting services off-premises. Facilities includes use of café space with coffee service provided for duration and reasonable direction of use of audio-visual equipment.

C. USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF FOR VIEWINGFAMILY TIME

Staff, facilities, and equipment necessary for conducting visitation, calling hours, or gathering time OR, if facilities are not used, the additional time, staff, and equipment necessary for conducting services off-premises. Facilities includes use of café space with coffee service provided for duration, reasonable direction of passive use of audio-visual equipment, and up to one hour prior for private family time and set-up of mementos, photo boards, and the like. Charges are for gatherings for a maximum of four (4) hours, not including initial accommodation hour.

A before-service gathering time (max 2 hours) is ½ the full charge

Additional charges will be incurred for gatherings of longer duration.

D. USE OF EQUIPMENT AND STAFF FOR COMMITTAL AND/OR INTERMENT SERVICES

Staff and equipment necessary for conducting graveside or mausoleum committal and/or interment services. Funeral services and visitations held at cemetery facilities - including at graveside - are not committal services and are billed as off- premises funeral services or visitations.

E. OVERTIME/WEEKEND SERVICE FEE

For any service, gathering, and/or event held any day starting at or after 4:00 pm or extending beyond 5:30 pm, as well as for any service, gathering, and/or event held on Saturday or Sunday.

F. PREPARATION AND CARE* (Embalming or Refrigeration)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Embalming is a surgical procedure which requires written permission to perform. Embalming provides temporary preservation and allows the survivors to hold services at a time convenient to them.

REFRIGERATION is <u>required</u> when <u>embalming</u> is <u>not</u> <u>performed</u>. This is a temporary means of holding the remains until disposition occurs. It does not preserve or disinfect the remains for purposes of viewing.

All costs related to compliance with the Federally Mandated OSHA Standards are included.

G. OTHER PREPARATION OF THE DECEASED \$495 Includes cosmetology, normal restoration of features, basic hair styling, dressing, placement of the deceased in the casket, and any other necessary procedures to make the deceased ready for viewing and/or services. Necessary authorizations and permits usually take three (3) days to eight (8) days to obtain and file (weekends are sometimes longer) and before any disposition (burial, cremation and/or shipping out of town) can take place, these permits must be in hand. Therefore, immediate burial and direct cremation services will take place only when these papers are obtained, not before.

PAYMENT POLICY

Our funeral home is a small business and like many others in our community, out of necessity, we operate on a cash basis, relying upon the families we serve for prompt payment. We do not have sufficient financial resources to extend credit over a period of months or years, nor does law allow us to fulfill the functions of a bank or other lending institution. Therefore payment is expected at time of arrangements. If payment in full is not completed at time of arrangements, a 50% down payment is required with the balance due in full at time of services.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payment with cash or check.

Payment with an approved Visa or MasterCard.

Pre-paid funeral arrangements with Warren Funeral Home, subject to verification the policy is valid.

Assignment of Proceeds of a Verified Life Insurance Policy. (additional fees apply). Warren Funeral Home is willing to accept the assignment of proceeds of a verified Life Insurance Policy for a cost of 5% of the amount assigned to Warren Funeral Home. Our acceptance of this mode of payment is dependent on the cooperation of the beneficiary and the insurance company. The insurance policy must be given to the funeral director for verification. We must have the Insurance Company's complete cooperation in providing information to the beneficiary, amount of the Death Benefit available, outstanding loans information, cooperation to get claim forms in a timely manner, and their acceptance of our written assignment. The insurance company will send the balance of any insurance proceeds directly to the beneficiary after the insurance company pays the funeral bill in full from the proceeds of the insurance policy. The purchaser must obtain a certified death certificate for each insurance policy.
