  - Baptism gave us grace for us, Confirmation gives us grace to serve others.









  - Record on Service Reflection





### **Confirmation Sponsor**

#### Guidelines . . .

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
- Is an active Catholic: attends mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation; receives the sacraments of the Church regularly.
- Is not the father or mother of the one to be confirmed

### Of the youth and family


- Grow in your conversion to Jesus Christ


