

USGA Rules Govern All Play

Unless Modified by Local Rules

— LOCAL RULES —

- Protected wetlands are marked with green or green-topped stakes or wooden fences. Entry into these areas is prohibited.
- Proper golf attire is required (collared shirts and no denim).
- All railroad ties are integral parts of the golf course.
- All players must have their own set of golf clubs.
- Wooden fences defining the wetland areas are to be played as an immovable obstruction. Rule 24-2
- If found playing with or possessing GVR range balls, you will lose your playing privileges.

— ETIQUETTE —

- Please remember, all players should complete 18 holes in 4 hours 30 minutes or less. Please be aware of your position on the course by staying within half a hole of the group in front of you.
- Carts are not allowed in native grass and wetlands.
- Cart path only on par 3s. Stay off areas designated as No Cart Zones by ropes and signs. For all other holes, follow the 90° Golf Cart Driving Rule.
- Personal beverages and coolers are not allowed on the premises.
- Please replace divots, fix ball marks and rake bunkers.
