

Fr. Tyler's Reflection on the Baptism of the Lord

On this Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we recall the moment when Jesus, humble and sinless, entered the waters of the Jordan. The heavens opened, the Holy Spirit descended like a dove, and the Father's voice resounded: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." These words reveal Jesus' deepest identity as the eternal Son of God. Yet, through our own baptism, they echo over each of us as well. In the waters of baptism, we are plunged into Christ's death and resurrection, reborn as adopted children of the Father. We become beloved sons and daughters, graced with the Holy Spirit, and called to live in the Father's pleasure. This identity is not earned but freely given—a gift that roots us in divine love amid life's uncertainties. As we begin Ordinary Time, let us renew our baptismal promises: to reject sin, embrace faith, and share Christ's light with the world. May we hear the Father's voice anew: "You are my beloved child." Live from this truth, and let it transform your daily life.

En esta Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, recordamos el momento en que Jesús, humilde y sin pecado, entró en las aguas del Jordán. Los cielos se abrieron, el Espíritu Santo descendió como paloma y resonó la voz del Padre: «Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia». Estas palabras revelan la identidad más profunda de Jesús como el Hijo eterno de Dios. Sin embargo, a través de nuestro bautismo, resuenan también en cada uno de nosotros. En las aguas del bautismo, nos sumergimos en la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, renacemos como hijos adoptivos del Padre. Nos convertimos en hijos amados, agradados con el Espíritu Santo y llamados a vivir en la complacencia del Padre. Esta identidad no se gana, sino que se da libremente: un don que nos arraiga en el amor divino en medio de las incertidumbres de la vida. Al comenzar el Tiempo Ordinario, renovemos nuestras promesas bautismales: rechazar el pecado, abrazar la fe y compartir la luz de Cristo con el mundo. Que escuchemos de nuevo la voz del Padre: «Tú eres mi hijo amado». Vive desde esta verdad y deja que transforme tu vida diaria.


