Rooted to Rise

Strengthening Families, Building Legacies

In 2025, CHOICES celebrated 21 years of ministry under the theme Immeasurably More—and God was faithful. We served 1,054 clients through more than 4,200 visits. With our first full year of a second dedicated nurse, we performed 543 life-affirming ultrasounds, the most in our history.

So far, we've recorded 280 babies born—each one a miracle. Among them, 104 babies were born to mothers who initially came to us seeking abortion information. While we count the numbers, only the Lord knows the eternal impact of these lives. We close 2025 praising God for fulfilling His promise in Ephesians 3:20–21.

As we look to 2026, our theme is Rooted to Rise, grounded in Colossians 2:6–7 (ESV):

“Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.”

Growth depends on where you're planted. This year, CHOICES is intentionally deepening roots and raising up families—one life and one legacy at a time.

Our staff, volunteer mentors, and class leaders are placing an even stronger emphasis on giving clients a firm foundation in the Gospel so families can flourish in the truth of God's Word. With this focus, we rebranded our programs:

Rooted and Ready (Parenting Program)

Legacy Builders (Fatherhood Program)

While programs have evolved over the years, our mission remains the same: share Christ, save babies, and equip parents.

Rooted and Ready allows mentors to invest more deeply in one-on-one relationships while also providing group classes and material support for clients who aren't yet ready for individual mentoring.


Legacy Builders reflects our commitment to strong families through engaged fathers. In 2025, 120 dads were served by volunteer mentors. To strengthen this effort, we added our first-ever paid Fatherhood Director, who will lead and expand this vital ministry.

We are praying that 2026 will be a year when more men stand for life and more fathers are equipped to build godly legacies. Rooted in Christ, we're ready to rise.

Legacy Builders

We all have a father experience, even if that experience was the absence of a father. Those experiences impact how men will father their own children. Legacy Builders asks men these two questions: What kind of father are you now? What kind of father do you want to be? Our male mentors discuss the things men can do to become loving fathers who provides guidance and support—the kind of fathers their kids need them to be. Dads are encouraged to adopt parenting styles that will make their children more successful and happier in life. They also learn how to best support the mothers of their children and are challenged to create healthy and long lasting relationships.



Rooted and Ready

Rooted and Ready is a Christian parenting program designed with the individualized needs of each parent in mind. Moms and Dads walk through various topics from parenting to life skills. With sincerity and vulnerability, our mentors speak directly to mothers, offering encouragement, solidarity, and practical wisdom for the journey. This program is designed to uplift and remind clients of the beauty and holiness of their role. Through personal stories and honest reflections, they will be equipped to embrace the triumphs and weather the trials of motherhood, knowing



God is with them every step of the way. We encourage self worth and healthy, stable, Christ-centered parenting relationships that all children need. We mentor them and help them feel Rooted in God's Word and Ready to become the parents that God has called them to be. Parents earn diapers and needed items at each attended appointment.



During this time, she has served as receptionist, Client Services Director, nurse sonographer, interim Nurse Manager, and Resource Specialist.

Lives Saved. The Impact of Life Affirming Care

“ Lori* was 15 years old when she gave birth to her first child and her baby’s father died shortly afterward, leaving her as a single mom. Now in her early twenties, she came to us for a pregnancy test, which was positive.

A few days after her appointment, she texted me and asked about abortion information. The father of this baby told her in no uncertain terms that he didn’t want to be a dad. She came in two days later for an ultrasound and I reminded her how brave she was at just 15 to have chosen life, and now she was older and even stronger. She joined the parenting program and is determined to have the baby with or without her boyfriend.

The Impact of the Blessing Boutique

“ When Maria came to CHOICES, she was nearing the end of her pregnancy and running out of options. She worried about how she would provide the basics for her baby, like diapers, clothes, and a safe place to sleep.

Through parenting classes, Maria earned needed items from the Blessing Boutique. She also received a referral for a new car seat. With each visit, her confidence grew—and so did her supplies. Soon, her once-empty apartment held a portable crib, baby clothes, and diapers ready for her son’s arrival.

After baby Jack was born, Maria returned to the center, smiling as she held him close. “You didn’t just help me with things,” she said. “You helped me believe I could be a good mom.” Because sometimes, hope comes wrapped in love—and a onesie or two.

Rebekah Hagan



Raised in a Christian home where abortion was never discussed, Rebekah's journey into the pro-life movement was unexpected and deeply personal. At 17, she chose life for her firstborn, but when faced with her second unplanned pregnancy, she was terrified of losing her support system and began a chemical abortion that changed her life forever. She was one of the first women to benefit from Abortion Pill Reversal. She now uses her testimony to expose the realities of abortion and advance the mission of the Pregnancy Help Movement.
