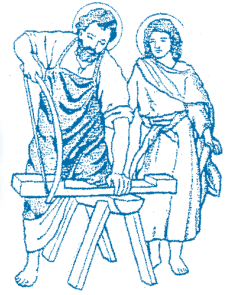
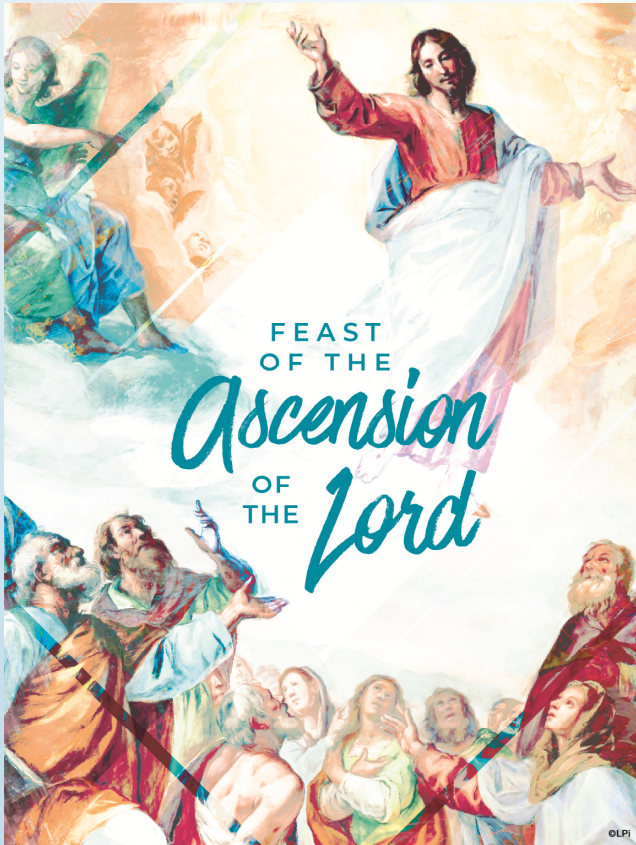

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

On June 7, three men will be ordained to the priesthood for service in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis: Deacon Thomas Day, Deacon Liam Hosty, and Deacon Isaac Siefker. This coming fall, we anticipate ordaining five seminarians to the transitional diaconate. Our Archdiocese has been blessed with a healthy number of seminarians and ordinations in recent years, for which we give thanks to God.

The weekend of June 7 and 8, we will hold our annual collection for the Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests. This collection supports our seminarians currently studying for future priestly ministry in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Your contributions help cover the expenses involved in the education and formation of these future priests. We anticipate having about 28 seminarians this coming fall, including 8 new men who will be entering formation. We are blessed to have these men in formation in two seminaries right here in the Archdiocese, Bishop Simon Bruté College Seminary and Saint Meinrad School of Theology.

The average cost per seminarian for educational expenses is about \$55,000 per year. Funds from the United Catholic Appeal and proceeds from designated endowments support the formation of our seminarians, but those sources do not fulfill the entire need. All donations to this special annual collection will go directly toward the payment of these expenses.

In the name of all who minister in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, I ask you to be generous in supporting the educational needs of our future priests. Most importantly, I encourage you to pray for our priests and seminarians, and for a generous increase in vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life.

Thank you, and know of my continued prayers for you.
