Babylon crushed them
and led them into exile
1,000 miles away. But
they have some
tokens for good: the
temple is rebuilt and
David's family is
preserved.

II CHRONICLES is a re-
spect of the books of
Samuel and Kings.
In I Chronicles, God
cries out, "I'm for you!"
In II Chronicles, God
cries out, "Are you for
Me?"

EZRA tells of the Jews'
return to ashes and rock
piles, and it inspires eve-
ryone facing the
intimidating challenge of
rebuilding his life, his
home, or his faith.

NEHEMIAH is a classic.
As the king's cupbearer,
he persuades the king to
support rebuilding the
walls, and he outsmarts
the local opposition.
