## Course overview

Students will be introduced to a variety of experiences exploring a range of photographic media, techniques and processes. They will explore relevant images, artefacts and resources relating to Photography and students responses to these examples will be shown through practical and critical activities which demonstrate understanding of different styles, genres and traditions. Students will use sketchbooks, workbooks and journals to underpin their work where appropriate and may use traditional methods and/or digital techniques to produce images.

## Exam / Coursework

The course is currently 100% coursework. Students will develop a photographic portfolio supported by a written element including between 1000-3000 words.
