SUNLAND PARK POLICE OFFICER RECOGNIZED AS NEW MEXICO'S DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT OF THE YEAR 2025

Los Lunas, N.M. - STATEWIDE – January 21, 2026 – The New Mexico Drug Recognition Expert Program is proud to recognize **Sergeant Armando Duran** of the **Sunland Park Police Department** as the **2025 DRE of the Year**. Since becoming a certified Drug Recognition Expert in May 2021, Sergeant Duran has exemplified the highest standards of leadership, initiative, and dedication to traffic safety and professional excellence that this award celebrates.

Sergeant Duran currently serves as the Southern Region alternate representative on the NMDRE Committee, a role that reflects the respect and confidence he has earned throughout the state. Beyond his enforcement responsibilities, he is widely regarded as a trusted resource of knowledge and mentorship. In 2025, he continued to strengthen partnerships with neighboring agencies, conducting DRE evaluations, providing guidance on complex cases, and leading DWI refresher training and full certification courses for his department as well as others. His responsiveness and willingness to assist fellow agencies exemplify the collaborative spirit of the DRE program.

Sergeant Duran made history as the first Drug Recognition Expert in the Sunland Park Police Department, a milestone that underscores his dedication to the community and to the mission of roadway safety. Known statewide as a go-to expert for DWI and DRE related matters, he continually seeks opportunities to strengthen his knowledge and better serve both the law enforcement community and the public.

Sergeant Duran's leadership, integrity, selfless service, dedication, and professionalism clearly set him apart. He will be formally recognized for this achievement at the New Mexico DRE Committee Meeting in Albuquerque on March 23, 2026. In addition, he has been invited to attend the International Association of Chiefs of Police Conference on Impaired Driving and Traffic Safety in Anaheim, California, an opportunity that highlights the national impact of his work in 2025.
