



GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCORAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

August 17, 2025 - 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 12:49-53

During my baseball career, my best coach often said, "You shouldn't be worried if I yell at you. Be worried if I don't. If I stop pushing you, it means I don't think you have any more potential." He demanded a lot, and I knew it meant he saw that I could be something special on the baseball field.

Jesus says some demanding words to us this week. "Do you think I have come to establish peace on the earth?" he asks, "No, tell you, but rather division" (Luke 12:51). He wants you and me-in fact, all the earth-to participate in the luminous glory of God. That's why he speaks of himself as a divine arsonist. Divine fire is like a good coach: it demands the removal of all that obstructs the achievement of the lofty goal.

How is your life demanding right now? That inconvenient family situation, the unfair boss at work, the kids who reject their parents' wishes, the nagging health issue? Maybe things would be more peaceful devoid of these seemingly arbitrary difficulties. But for us who believe in the one who comes to set the earth of fire, we should be much more worried if he stops demanding so much from us. In fact, let's thank him for it. He sees how glorious we can become.

2025 Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu

Next Weekend: August 23 & 24 2025

The Mission of the Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu will be taken as a second collection next weekend. Little Sister of Mary Immaculate of Gulu in Northern Uganda was founded in 1936. The LSMIG are uniquely serving a people who are emerging from nearly 30 yrs. of devastating civil war with an influx of refugees. Many of the refugees are little girls who have suffered sexual violence, which left them pregnant

The sisters are responding to the needs of the child-mothers and children in the refugee camps by expanding the school feeding program to include breakfast & lunch. strengthening the school health program by stocking enough medical supplies in the school infirmary and by purchasing educational supplies such as text books, exercise books and pen for the daycare, the kindergarten and elementary classes.

We kindly invite you to consider financial support for the mission of the **Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu** to break the cycle of child- motherhood in the refugee camps and to impart our Catholic values of God's love and kindness to these children through catholic education.
