Setting up a hot chocolate bar is straightforward - just combine a crockpot of hot chocolate with a variety of toppings at a dedicated station. For your party, you'll need: hot cocoa mix or a batch of homemade hot chocolate, hot milk and/or water, mugs, spoons, and topping containers like small bowls or jars. You can also add trays for organization and signs for labeling the different options. Don't forget to include some sweet treats like cookies - store-bought or homemade. If you're new to hot cocoa bars, you might be surprised by the numerous fun toppings out there! Here are some ideas: chocolate chips in various flavors, caramel chips, cinnamon sticks, whipped cream, sprinkles, marshmallows, shredded coconut, candy canes, peppermint sticks, and flavored syrups. You'll need some ingredients for a holiday hot chocolate bar, such as Bailey's liqueur or Irish cream syrup, Kahlua, Peppermint Schnapps, Vodka or whiskey, and chocolate bars. To make it look great, consider placing the hot chocolate bar sign in a prominent spot behind the table. The printables that come with this set include extra signs to place around the table for an even more festive look. It's best to keep your hot chocolate warm in a slow cooker so it stays nice and toasty throughout the party. Just be sure to stir it occasionally. You can also use a large thermal coffee carafe, which is convenient because you just push the lever on top to dispense the milk. However, this option might be more expensive, but it's easier for guests to pour their own milk. The other option holds less milk and requires guests to pour it themselves. To create them, use lollipop sticks or toothpicks and attach small circles punched from cardstock to the sticks with tape. A personalized thank-you message is always appreciated, so consider adding a favor tag to a Christmas cookie cutter or a bag of homemade cookies. These snowflake plaid water bottle labels can be used to match the rustic hot cocoa bar theme, adding them to glass milk bottles, water bottles, or paper cups. For an extra festive touch, add themed straw flags, such as "hot chocolate", "Merry Christmas", and "happy holidays" to paper straws or wood drink stirrers. The Merry Christmas banner can be created by cutting out individual letters, punching holes in each corner of the flag, and threading coordinating string, twine, or ribbon through. A buffalo plaid table runner would provide a cozy foundation for the hot chocolate bar station. When printing the hot chocolate bar printables, use 8.5x11 inch cardstock to ensure durability and long-lasting use.
