The Triduum: Walking with Jesus

The Triduum is the most special time of the whole Church year.

It is a three-day journey where we walk with Jesus through His final days— from the Last Supper to the Cross, and finally to His Resurrection.

It begins on Holy Thursday, continues through Good Friday, and ends with the joy of Easter.

Holy Thursday – The Last Supper

On Holy Thursday, we remember when Jesus shared a special meal with His closest friends. He washed their feet to show them how to love and serve others. He also gave us the very first Mass when He said, "This is my body... this is my blood." Jesus teaches us to love, serve, and stay close to Him in the Eucharist.

Good Friday – Jesus' Great Love

Good Friday is a quiet and serious day. We remember how Jesus died on the cross because He loves us so much. Even though it is a sad day, we remember that Jesus did this to save us and bring us closer to God.

Holy Saturday & Easter – Waiting and Joy

Holy Saturday is a quiet day of waiting. We wait with Mary and Jesus' friends in hope. Then we celebrate the happiest news ever at the Easter Vigil or on Easter Sunday: Jesus is alive. He has risen from the dead. Because of Him, we have new life and hope.

Final Thought

The Triduum is not just something we learn about—it is something we experience.

When we walk through all three days, we begin to understand how much Jesus loves us.
