

CATHOLICS LOVE TO CELEBRATE—FAITH, FAMILY, JOY, HOPE, NEW LIFE, AND GOD'S GOODNESS. AND CHRISTMAS IS ONE OF OUR BIGGEST CELEBRATIONS! BUT DID YOU KNOW CHRISTMAS ISN'T JUST ONE DAY? FOR CATHOLICS, CHRISTMAS BEGINS ON DECEMBER 25 AND LASTS FOR 12 BEAUTIFUL DAYS, ENDING THE DAY BEFORE EPIPHANY. THIS IS WHY YOU CAN KEEP YOUR DECORATIONS UP LONGER—BECAUSE THE CHURCH IS STILL CELEBRATING! THE POPULAR SONG "THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS" HAS OLD CATHOLIC ROOTS. EACH GIFT IN THE SONG POINTS TO A PART OF OUR FAITH. HERE IS A SIMPLE WAY FOR FAMILIES TO FIND MEANING IN EACH DAY.

DAY 1 — A PARTRIDGE IN A PEAR TREE
MEANING: JESUS. WHO GAVE HIS LIFE FOR US.

FAMILY IDEA: TAKE 5 QUIET MINUTES TO THANK JESUS FOR HIS LOVE. KIDS CAN DRAW A BIRD IN A TREE.

DAY 2 - TWO TURTLE DOVES

MEANING: THE OLD AND NEW TESTAMENTS.

FAMILY IDEA: READ ONE SHORT BIBLE VERSE FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT AND ONE FROM THE NEW.

DAY 3 - THREE FRENCH HENS

MEANING: FAITH, HOPE, AND LOVE.

FAMILY IDEA: DO 3 SIMPLE GOOD DEEDS—ONE THAT SHOWS FAITH, ONE THAT GIVES HOPE, ONE THAT SHOWS LOVE.

DAY 4 - FOUR CALLING BIRDS

MEANING: THE FOUR GOSPELS-MATTHEW, MARK, LUKE, JOHN.
FAMILY IDEA: READ A FAVORITE GOSPEL VERSE TOGETHER.

DAY 5 - FIVE GOLDEN RINGS

MEANING: THE FIRST FIVE BOOKS OF THE BIBLE (GENESIS-DEUTERONOMY).

FAMILY IDEA: SHARE YOUR FAVORITE BIBLE STORY FROM THESE BOOKS (CREATION, NOAH, MOSES, ETC.).

DAY 6 - SIX GEESE A-LAYING

MEANING: THE SIX DAYS OF CREATION.

FAMILY IDEA: GO OUTSIDE AND ENJOY GOD'S CREATION-TAKE A SHORT WALK OR LOOK FOR SOMETHING BEAUTIFUL.

DAY 7 - SEVEN SWANS A-SWIMMING

MEANING: THE SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

FAMILY IDEA: PRAY, "COME HOLY SPIRIT," TOGETHER.

DAY 8 - EIGHT MAIDS A-MILKING

MEANING: THE EIGHT BEATITUDES.

FAMILY IDEA: PICK ONE BEATITUDE AND TRY TO LIVE IT THAT DAY (BE KIND, BE PEACEFUL, FORGIVE SOMEONE, ETC.).

DAY 9 - NINE LADIES DANCING

MEANING: THE NINE FRUITS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

FAMILY IDEA: TALK ABOUT WHICH FRUIT YOUR FAMILY WANTS TO GROW IN (LOVE, PATIENCE, JOY, ETC.).

DAY 10 - TEN LORDS A-LEAPING

MEANING: THE TEN COMMANDMENTS.

FAMILY IDEA: CHOOSE ONE COMMANDMENT TO FOCUS ON LIVING BETTER TODAY.

DAY 11 - ELEVEN PIPERS PIPING

**MEANING: THE 11 FAITHFUL APOSTLES.** 

FAMILY IDEA: READ ONE SHORT STORY ABOUT AN APOSTLE (PETER WALKING ON WATER, JOHN AT THE CROSS, ETC.).

DAY 12 - TWELVE DRUMMERS DRUMMING

MEANING: THE 12 PARTS OF THE APOSTLES' CREED—OUR BASIC CATHOLIC BELIEFS.

FAMILY IDEA: PRAY THE APOSTLES' CREED TOGETHER.
