PRACTICING STEWARDSHIP

Oooh, Mary, she's so holy. Well, do you like to eat, Mary? Who made your lunch? Yeah, that's right: it was Martha. Afterall, it's the Marthas who get things done while the Marys lounge around reading Aquinas and attending retreats and going to Eucharistic Adoration. My bitterness is on full display! I tend to identify with Martha, not with Mary, and I need to stop that. I am both. We are all both. It's wrong to assume that Mary didn't have the same anxieties as Martha. Here's the difference: Mary, unlike Martha (and me, I guess) knew where to go with them. We typically see our burdens as an impediment to a relationship with Christ. There are so many demands on me, on my time, on my finances. Take a number, Jesus. But we're thinking the wrong way. Burdens aren't an obstacle that stands between us and Christ. Burdens are the straightest path to his feet. God knows about burdens. He suffered, taking on a human form and for three decades lived among the hardest and heaviest burdens this world has to offer. Why? Well, part of the reason was so that we could finally understand that our burdens aren't a barrier between us and God. On the contrary, they connect us to him. Are you anxious about many things? Then you need to be right where Mary is: at the feet of Jesus, with all your burdens.-Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman
