We cannot rely on proximity—"We ate and drank in your company"—but must live as true disciples, walking daily in faith, humility, and love. The Kingdom of God is open to all, yet entry requires more than comfort or convenience. It calls for perseverance, conversion, and trust in God's mercy. The challenge of the narrow gate becomes our hope, because through Christ, even what seems impossible is made possible. (Luke 13:22-30)

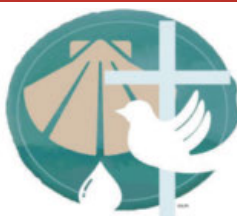

PRACTICING STEWARDSHIP

Certain phrases act like secret passwords for millennials—cultural cues that only those who grew up between 1981 and 1996 instantly recognize. “You can’t sit with us!” is one of them. It’s from the movie “Mean Girls.” Regina, the merciless ruler of the cool kids, is rejected from the exclusive lunch table when her minions, tired of her cruelty, serve her the most devastating words a teen can hear in public: “You can’t sit with us.” This weekend’s Gospel has “Mean Girls” vibes. We have an image of the unlucky masses clamoring for entry into heaven as God locks the door, saying, “I do not know where you are from.” Sound familiar? But we need to remember that these people pounding on the door aren’t people who wanted a seat at God’s lunch table—at least, not until it was the only lunch table left, because they had Regina’d their way out of all the other ones. Jesus’ whole thing was that you can sit with us, whoever you are, wherever you’re from and whatever you’ve done. But there are a lot of lunch tables in the world, and not everyone wants to be at one with rules like “repent” and “be good to that person you really don’t like.” It’s not always an easy table, especially when there are so many other options. Let's give a shout-out to our Traffic Team!!

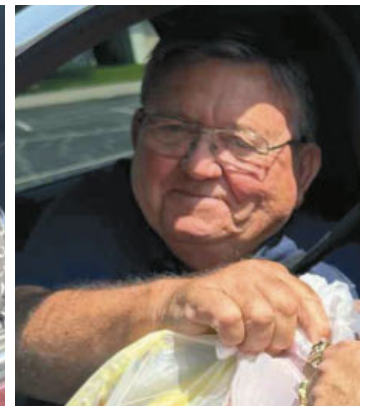
Thanks for your support at the Drive-Thru
