Did you know that all women of the parish are considered members of St. Joseph's CCW? It's up to you if you want to be active or not.

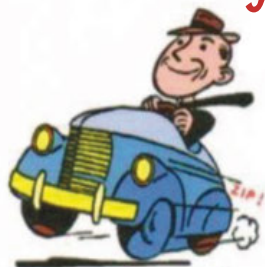

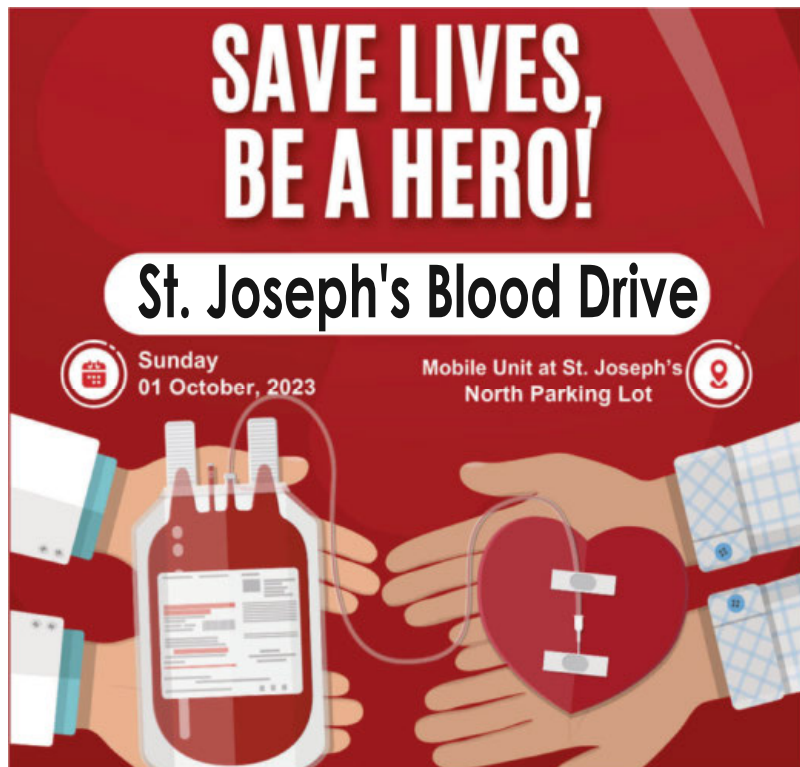

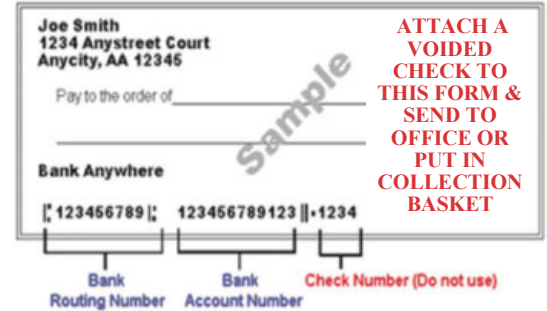
