Competition can—and should—mean witness. Think of the Olympics. There's a competition that isn't a conquest or a performance but rather a celebration of ability, hard work, and effort. Does anything glorify God more than that? Let's strive to be competitive, but with the competitive nature of an everyday steward: that which seeks the good of all running the race.

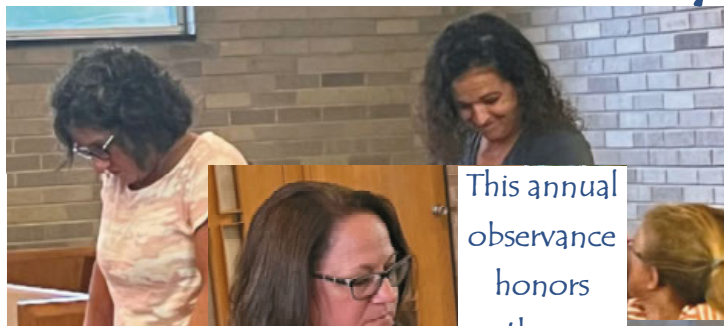

Knights In Action!

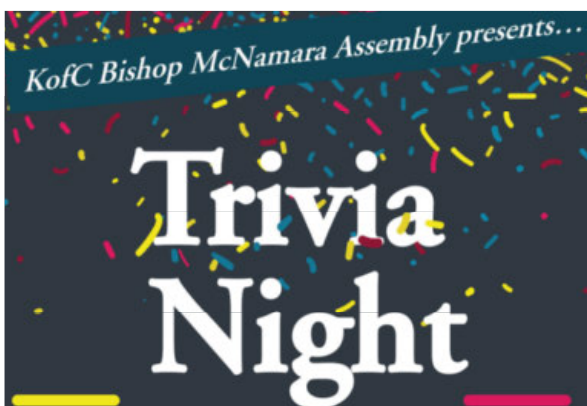
