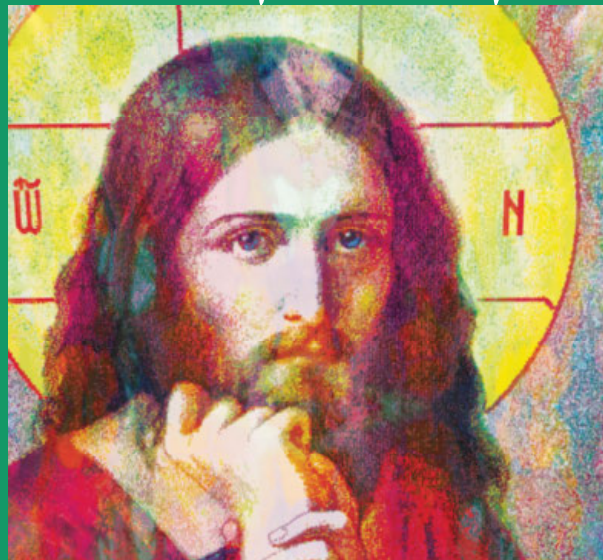

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

The news is almost too much sometimes, isn't it? The twenty-four-hour coverage doesn't help. Add social media and it's enough to push anyone into a nervous breakdown. When you find yourself in this place, remember St. Paul's words, "Work quietly and eat your own food." Poking our noses into other people's business, we may think we are getting a shortcut to the right answer, but we're really just getting distracted. When we become too preoccupied with events that we cannot control—whether they are happening in our neighborhood or half-a-world away—we are tempted to leave off the very specific work God has given us in our own lives. We are easily lured into anger, bitterness, and anxiety. What is the work that God has called you to? Is it your career? Your family? Your community? What is your food—what nourishes you, sustains you, connects you to something real, powerful, and life-giving? This is what you should be concerned with. This is where your thoughts and your efforts should be. Work quietly and eat your own food.

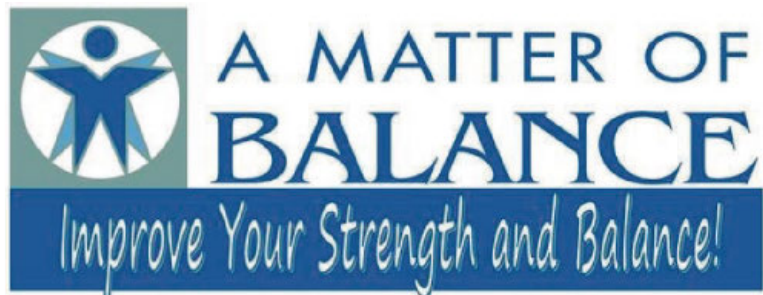
Mobile Pantry Team appreciates your candy donations!

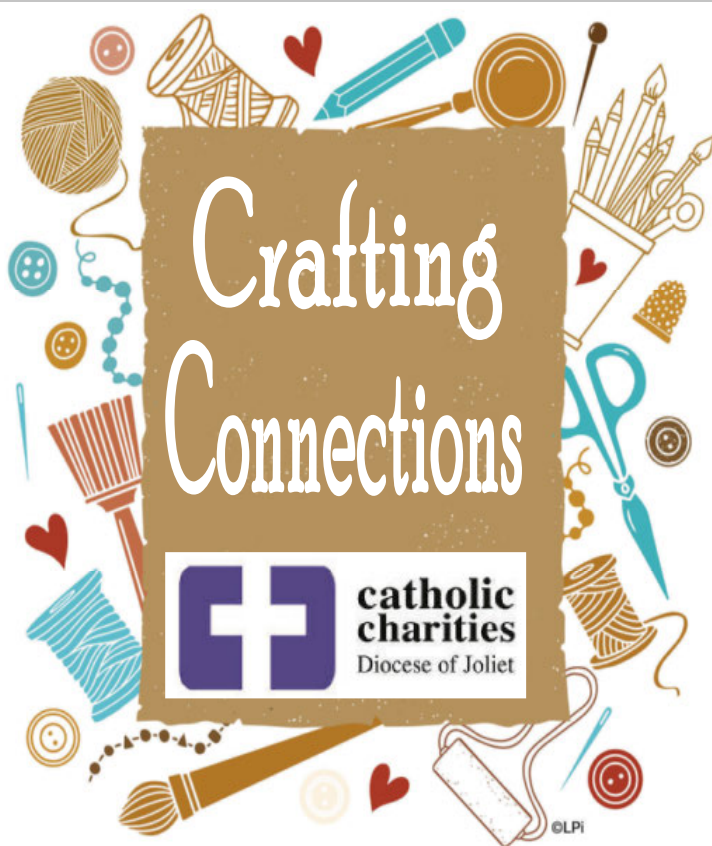
VETERAN'S DAY AT ST. JOSEPH'S

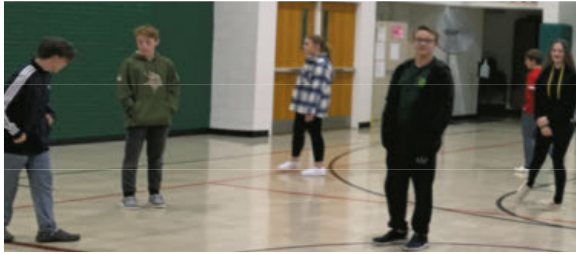
