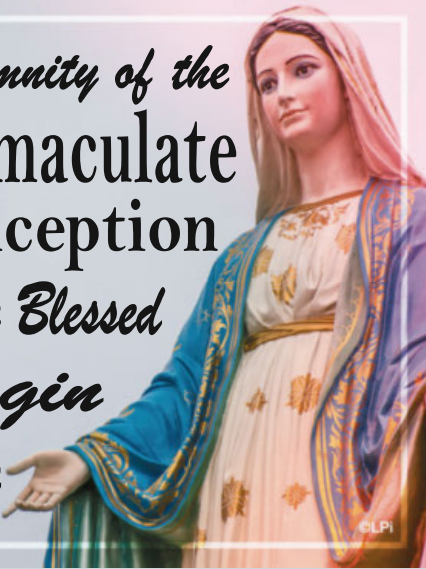

Please mark your calendar and plan on attending this celebration of Our Parish, Our Family as we welcome Bishop Hicks to St. Joseph Parish in Bradley!



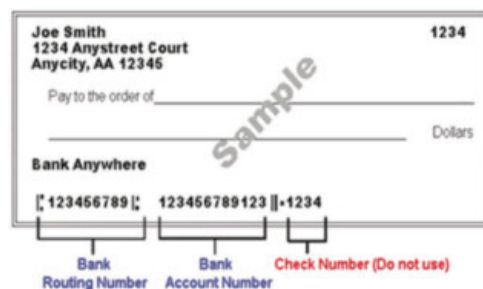
