



#### **EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP**

The world is watching! A parent can use one bad word, do one selfish thing, utter one unkind commentary, and that's what the child will notice. When mom or dad gets called on it, the only thing she or he can do is come clean. "Yep, I did that." It's a good thing we are all works in progress. God never stops working on us. I think it's fair to say that we don't think enough about the wounds of Christ. It's a lot to handle, the physical trauma of a crucifixion. But the wounds of Christ are the only thing that could make Thomas believe. Literally nothing else was as powerful. Only by looking at and feeling the torn flesh—by beholding that messy reality—did this Apostle come to believe in the Resurrection. "Christ has no body now but yours," said St. Teresa of Avila, explaining that we are the means through which God chooses to accomplish His will in the world. Us, the broken. Us, the weary. Us, the imperfect. Yes, miraculous events and apparitions still occur from time to time, but by and large, if a person is going to come to believe in Jesus Christ in this day and age, it will be because of something we Christians do or say. Similarly, don't forget that Christ has no wounds now but ours. Our brokenness, our weariness, our imperfection—our reality. It all belongs to him, and the world is watching.-Tracy Earl Welliver




