## **Online Annulment Support Day**

Working on an annulment without support can be overwhelming. In an effort to help petitioners complete the process, the Office for Family Ministry and Diocesan Tribunal, will offer an optional Day of Support on Saturday, Jan. 22, from 9 a.m.-noon via Zoom.

This free workshop is designed for those who have already started the annulment process with the Diocesan Tribunal, have submitted their Fact Sheet and have a current case in process but have not yet completed the Summary Long/Questionnaire. Catholics as well as non-Catholics are welcome to attend, whether remarried or not.

The day will include time for prayer and reflection, a witness talk, and time for questions related to the long questionnaire. Registration is required by Jan. 17 at https://bit.ly/2Bv0drA. The Zoom link will be emailed upon registration.
