

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

My friend's grandmother was famous for giving her children some blunt advice when they left the house: "Eyes straight ahead. Mind your own business." She could not anticipate every scenario they would encounter, but she could distill what she knew about life, safety, and manners into a few words. And long after she was gone, her aging children repeated these words to themselves over and over again. Jesus does the same for us in the Gospels. "Ask the master to send out laborers for his harvest...Eat what is set before you...Know that the Kingdom of God is at hand." He knows us best—knows our strengths, but even more importantly, he knows our weaknesses. He doesn't always have the space to address each of these explicitly in Scripture, but what he can do is distill the truth into a few words for our journey through life.
