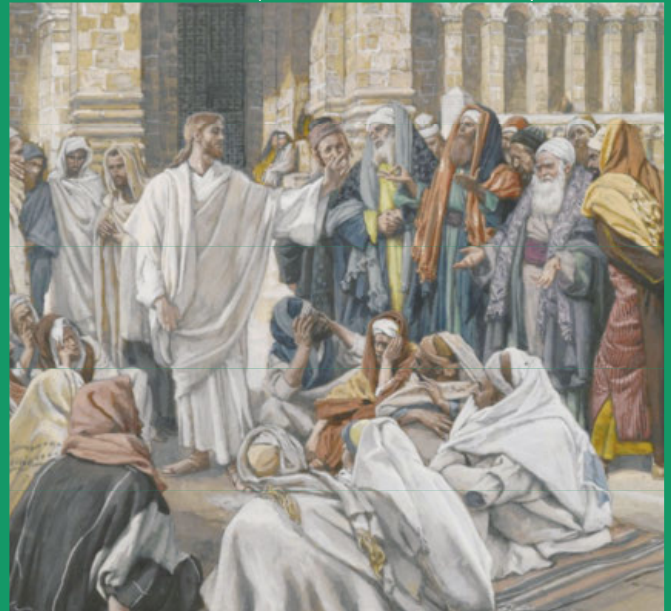

Parish Religious Education Registration Opens Soon!

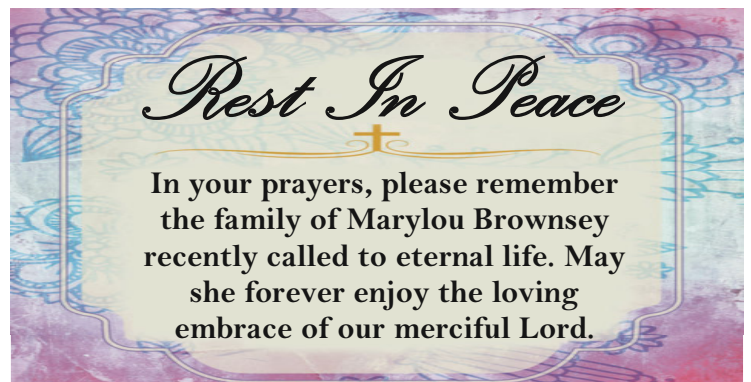

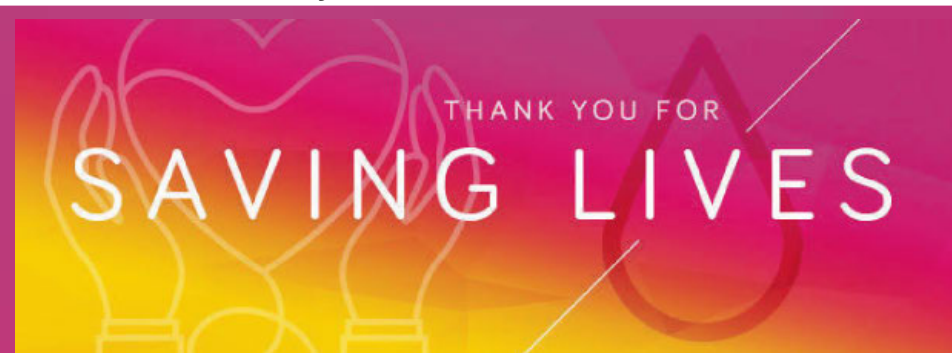

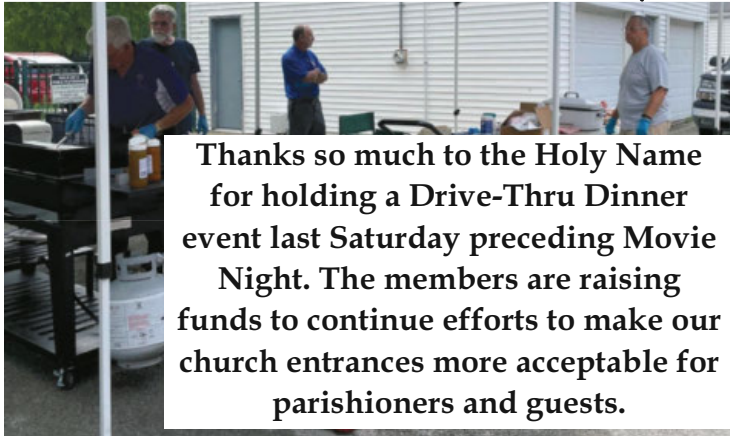
A total of 27 volunteers from our Mobile Food Pantry Team and their friends and family members assisted at the fair!
