EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Here's my idea for a leadership conference: The Management Style of the Apostles. Think about it, the only thing the Apostles had more abundantly than holiness was problems. It's no small feat, starting Christ's Church on earth. The Acts of the Apostles chronicles these problems and ways to solve them. It's a blueprint for tackling interpersonal issues in the manner of a true steward, who encounters every problem starting from the same place: What would my Master want? It's a question we should be asking ourselves every time we, too, encounter a problem—especially problems relating to other people. What is the truth in this situation, and how would God have me communicate it? In Acts, we see a lot of characteristics of everyday stewardship. The Apostles prayerfully confront the obstacles to salvation posed by these issues. Always, always, their main objective is to reveal the will of God, remaining committed to the truth while helping newcomers find avenues to salvation. Maybe I'm just saying it because it's my idea—but it sounds like a conference we could all use.-Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS


