

## Car Wash Fundraiser Throughout Jume Get Tokens Next Two Weekends

Our Mobile Pantry Team is partnering with Big Express Car Wash on Route 50 in Bradley to raise some extra funds.

The support from the parish continues to be tremendous with the monthly envelope. Those funds are earmarked specifically for purchasing the food and transportation to our location. Proceeds from this fundraiser, however, will go toward costs of supplies, such as traffic signs, safety equipment and carts.

Throughout the month of June, we will have Car Wash Tokens for sale for \$10 each. These are for the Biggest Wash (regularly \$16). For every token we sell, the Food Pantry will receive \$5.

For the next two weekends, we will have volunteers at the Masses selling these tokens. Again, you will receive a \$16 car wash for just \$10 and help raise money for the incidental costs of our Mobile Food Pantry. Thanks for your ongoing support of this outreach.

Try Googling "famous last words." There are websites devoted to the final utterances of celebrities and historical figures. We want to ascribe some kind of power and significance to the last words they say, especially from our loved ones, because it gives us something to carry with us.

In Jesus' case, every word he ever said had power and significance, but especially those he said before ascending into Heaven: "You will be my witnesses ... to the ends of the earth." And then he was gone. If I were one of the Apostles, I think a small anxiety attack would have commenced at that point. As much as they knew and believed that Christ was still with them, it must have felt awfully lonely standing there staring at an empty sky, with the mother of all homework assignments having just been handed down. Stewardship is intimidating by nature. When we doubt

ourselves, let's return to Christ's last words and cling to the faith he had in his Father's love for us. He says not "you will be witnesses" but "you are witnesses." We already have
