- Operational Costs: Staff salaries, training, utilities, insurance, supplies.
- Regulatory Compliance: Safety upgrades, audits, record-keeping systems.
- Growth & Expansion: New facilities, marketing, recruitment, acquisitions.
- Contingency & Emergencies: Repairs, temporary staff, crisis response.
- Technology & Innovation: Telecare, rostering systems, client engagement platforms.


