Bedding Area Weed Control

Today, _____, we treated your Ornamental Bedding areas (where possible):

- ____ With pre-emergent weed control
- ____ With post-emergent weed control
- ____ For Bermuda grass control in bedding areas

What To Do Next:

- Keep pets and people off sprayed areas until dry, usually about 1 hour.
- Wait 24 hours or more, then thoroughly water for 15 to 20 minutes. Watering helps maximize the effectiveness of the weed control by moving it into the soil

When can I expect to see results?

- Broadleaf weeds typically will begin to change color and start dying in 5-10 days.
- Bermuda grass and grassy weeds often show symptoms after approximately 7-10 days.
- REMEMBER: Notify us when re-mulching the bedding areas. Pre-emergent needs to be applied on top of the new mulch for best results in controlling new weed germination.

To avoid this, please ensure that your gate is unlocked and your pets are secured.

Touchup Policy: Weed control applications are warranted for 30 days after service. Touch-ups between applications are provided (if needed) at no charge for clients who have selected the PLC Preferred Service Plan. For clients with reduced service plans, touch-ups requested after the 30-day warranty period will be available, but there may be a charge for the application.
