PITON HIKE

Take the ultimate St. Lucian challenge and climb to the peak of the world-famous Gros Piton, designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and described by Oprah Winfrey as One of the top places you must see during life.

The Pitons are two volcanic plugs located near the towns of Soufriere and Choiseul on the southwestern coast of the island. The Gros Piton is 771 m, and the Petit Piton is 743 m high; they are linked by the Piton Miton ridge. There are still sulfur springs and hot mud pools in the nearby Soufriere caldera, visible remnants of former volcanic activity in the area.

BRIGAND HIKE—A trip by bus down the west coast to Soufriere, passing by Marigot Bay, Anse La Raye & Anse Cochon. In the village of Canaries is popular freshly baked bread, for your enjoyment. Your guide will then accompany you to the summit of Gros Piton, from which the view must be seen to be believed, with clear views across to Martinique to the north and St. Vincent to the south.

Be sure to get a photo – op near the World Heritage Site Monument.

It is proof that you made it to the top!

You will be picked up directly off the beach and greeted by our friendly and courteous staff.

The boat will then take you on a 35-minute ride to Anse Cochon which is a remote dark sandy beach with an adjacent reef perfect for snorkeling, or to Anse Chastanet (55-minute ride) with a reef that starts just 10 yards beyond the water's edge. These reef's remarkable ecosystem offers an amazing profusion of unusual tropical marine life in shallow calm and clear water that harbors 150 different species of fish.

You will board the boat off the beach and then head to *Saline Point* (20-minute ride) or *Pigeon Island* (15-minute ride). *Saline Point* is a tapering piece of land projecting into the water located off the LeSport hotel where you will enjoy snorkeling off the beach into the clear Caribbean waters, viewing the variety of marine life from Sargent Majors to squids and octopus, flying Gurnards, spotted drums and lots of tropical fish. *Pigeon Island* – This site is below the historic Pigeon Island National Landmark; the Point is famous for Fort Rodney and hosting the St. Lucia Jazz Festival culminating events. The site is home to an abundance of schooling fish, snappers, grunts and to non-schooling fish, flounders, scorpion fish. Squids, octopus and turtles are also found on this site. The dive usually starts off shallow and it progresses around the point where you can get a maximum depth of 60 feet.

ENDEMIC AND SPECIALTY BIRDS EXPEDITION

Tour Description:

Our first stop on the east coast of St. Lucia will be devoted to discovering the very much sought-after, the White-breasted Thrasher, and acquiring good views of this range-restricted endemic. We also have the opportunity to find the Saint Lucia Warbler, the Pewee and possibly, the Saint Lucia Black Finch. Other specialist birds to look for in this habitat are the Grey Trembler, the LA Saltator, the Green Throated Carib and the LA Crested Hummer.

We head to the beautiful and lush Des Cartier Rainforest trail for the highlight of the day; the opportunity to see the spectacular Saint Lucia Parrot, National Bird of Saint Lucia, and the most colorful parrot of the Amazona parrots. This will involve a leisurely walk up the gently sloping track from the entrance, stopping along the way searching for Saint Lucian endemics. Specialties like the Rufus throat Solitaire, the Grey Trembler, the LA Fly Catcher, the Antillean Euphonia, the Purple Throated Carib, the LA Swift and other rainforest dwelling birds can also be observed in this area. The day will conclude with the final stop at the Dennery fishing Port. This is where you will see the fishermen brining in their catch of the day, with a variety of fish species and Frigate birds scavenging for fish guts and scraps.
