KEY PRINCIPLES

 wide a range of the public as possible and will take steps to remove barriers which may
 prevent potential participants from having equal access to our activities;
- the Ashtead Ballet School management will be responsible for ensuring that this Equal Opportunities Policy is properly implemented, monitored and reviewed.
