*The Month of August is devoted to Mary,
the Mother of God.*



When we look at statues of Mary we might have the idea that she lived a very special, holy, out-of-the-ordinary life. In one sense that is true. However, Mary is addressed in the Litany of Our Lady as Virgin Most Prudent. Prudence is a virtuous capacity to make decisions within the largest horizon of truth. In this horizon, we see what is really important, we understand that while we see how things appear, the appearance points to something deeper and truer that we might not be able to readily see, appreciate, or accept. And finally, prudence helps us make decisions with confidence in the heavenly Father's providential care for us.

How did Mary, the Virgin Most Prudent, grow in this wisdom? The Scriptures give us four hints:

1) *In the Annunciation*, the Holy Spirit came upon Mary. The Spirit comes also upon us in our Baptism and Confirmation, and whenever we ask for the Spirit's counsel and comfort.

2) *Mary pondered everything in her heart*. Instead of reacting, analyzing, and blaming, this contemplative pondering deepens and blesses our lives.

3) *Mary stood beneath the cross*. Prudence grows in the face of what we can't control, comprehend, or change. We begin to see things God's way, when our thoughts no longer can make sense of what is happening.

4) *She prayed with the apostles in the Cenacle*. Mary knew herself as integrated in a community and took her place in the community in a prayerful way. Prudence leads us to see ourselves as part of a whole and responsible for the good of others.

Where do you need greater prudence in your life? Is there a situation that is difficult for you to live through or in which you are tempted to do imprudent things?

FAMILY FAITH FORMATION



Kindergarten - 5th Grade

Our Lady of the Assumption and Saint Ann by the Sea's faith formation program is family centered. We aim to foster a community in which parents and catechists journey together to form young disciples. In order to do so, our community must be an open-hearted community that is willing to grow together spiritually. It is our hope that in forming parents and family as the prime examples of how to know and love Jesus, we will not only be forming children, but also inspiring lifelong faith formation.

How does it work?

Family Faith Formation will be a hybrid program that blends in-church and at-home instruction, supplemented with at-church formation activities. Families will gather at least twice a month at church on Sunday afternoons or Tuesday evenings. Once a month, parents and children will come together for a group presentation for parents and children, followed by grade-level instruction for the children and small group instruction and discussion for the parents. Later in the month, parents and children will come together again for grade-level instruction on specific themes (Advent, Lent, Saints, Sacraments, etc.) and small-group faith sharing for parents. Families may choose either the Sunday or Tuesday timeslot for classes.

In between the two at-church classes, parents will be the primary catechists for students through at-home instruction. The presentations at church will include unit overviews to give the parents the keys they need for at-home instruction. The small groups are opportunities for parents to share their experiences with at-home instruction and provide support for one another. While this is a family centered, parent-led experience, no one is catechizing their child alone. The Family Faith Formation program relies heavily on journeying together as a community.

In addition to the classes, there will also be a supplemental Family Fun Night each month. Rather than formal classroom instruction, these nights bring the theology off the page into a tangible, livable format. Family Fun Nights will include an array of crafts, teaching masses, music, movies, and other engaging activities.

From March-May, Communion II students will have additional retreats in preparation for First Penance and First Eucharist.

How can you help?

We need catechists and volunteers to help this program run smoothly! We will be using the Christ Our Life program from Loyola Press as our primary resource for this program. The program comes with catechist guides and lesson plans, so you don't need to be a theologian or expert to teach.

RESTORE SUNDAY

The Third Commandment calls us to keep holy the Sabbath day.

After the Christian religion obtained its freedom under the Roman emperor Constantine in the fourth century, civil laws were passed to limit unnecessary work on Sunday. The greatest beneficiaries were the poor who otherwise worked long hours every day of the week. Centuries later, at the height of the Industrial Revolution, sweatshops were established in large cities where men, women, and children worked fifteen hours a day, often on Sundays.

Today in some places in our country, those seven-day sweatshops have returned. This is both an injustice to the poor and also an abuse of Sunday rest, and we need to find ways to correct this. "God's action is a model for human action. If God 'rested and was refreshed' on the seventh day, man too ought to 'rest' and should let others, especially the poor, 'be refreshed'" (CCC, no. 2172).

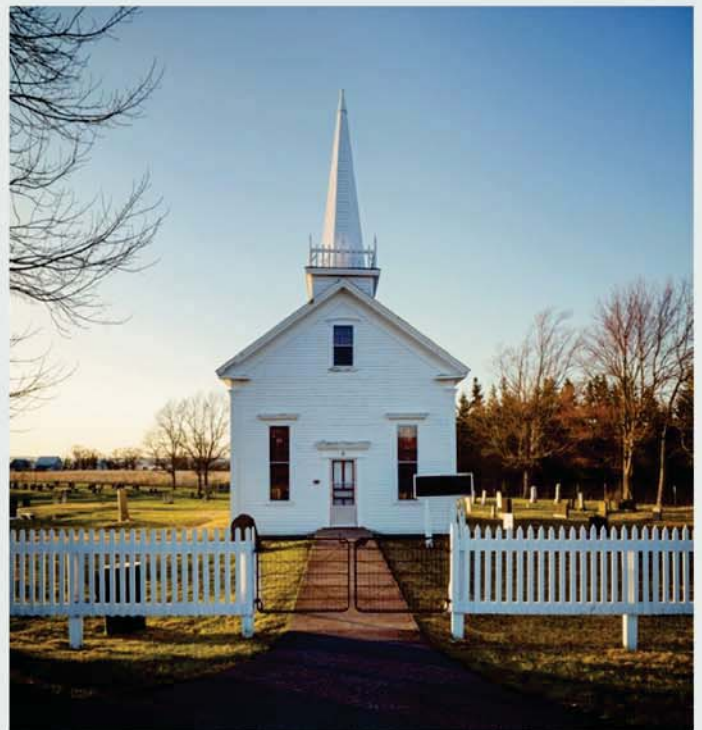
Millions of people in our culture deny themselves a day of rest. Exceptions are made for those who must work for the public good, but this is not the problem. Too many people are just as busy and exhausted on Sundays as they are on weekdays. For many, Sunday is neither a day of rest nor a time for worship.

Sunday rest puts our whole life into perspective. It helps us stand back from material concerns and reflect on spiritual values. Sunday rest allows us to look again at the wonders of nature and experience the harmony and peace placed there by God. It is a precious time for rediscovering the fundamental goodness of creation as it comes from God's providential hand.

Sunday also provides the opportunity for families to be together and to engage in common activities. Weekday schedules often require members of the family to spend much time away from each other. Participation in the Eucharist and other activities can renew the bonds of love and unity.

Athletic events for young people have sometimes interfered with the Sunday Mass observance of Catholic youth. Until recently, Sunday morning was a sacred time in most communities and neighborhoods, set aside for church attendance. Before this is abandoned on behalf of sports activities or other unexpected intrusions, it is hoped that Catholic pastors and other Christian religious leaders, with the support of their congregations, may prevail on sponsors of athletic events to adapt their programs to the religious needs of youth.

A proper observance of Sunday can thus be a prophetic stance in our culture, offering a witness that is both wholesome and healing for the great number of people who need to be less frantic and more willing to let go and settle down to what best corresponds to their spiritual nature and yearnings.
