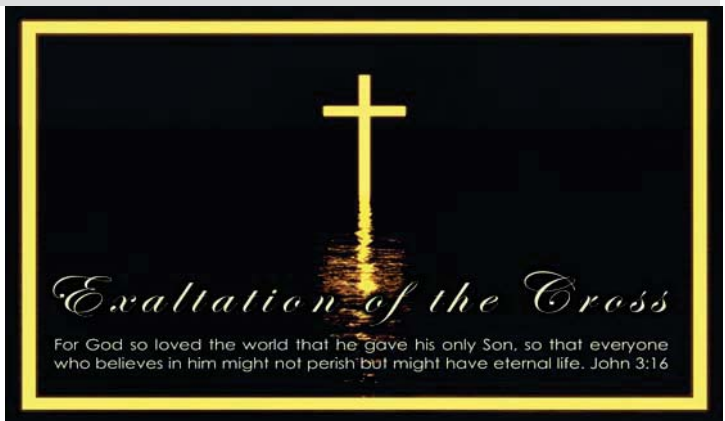

Fr. Jean Sassou Tounoussia was born in Dobia on September 14, 1980, Cameroon, in a family of four boys and two girls. He began his priestly formation at the Minor Seminary in Guider, Cameroon, and the Major Seminary in Maroua Cameroon, and was ordained a priest on June 14, 2008.

After serving in pastoral ministry and teaching in the Seminary, Father Jean came to the United States for advanced studies, he earned a Licentiate in Sacred Theology (SL) at Boston College, where he specialized in Biblical studies. He then continued his academic journey, obtaining a Doctorate (PhD) from Indiana Newburgh College of the Bible.

He teaches at the Major seminary in Maroua-Cameroon and currently serves as Parochial Vicar at Saint Mathew the Evangelist Parish in Billerica, Massachusetts.

I have been blessed in my twenty-seven years of priesthood to be assigned with some of the finest priests I have encountered, and Fr. Will is no exception. Our parish collaborative has benefitted greatly from his piety, fraternal spirit, love for God and His Church (particularly his reverence for the Eucharist), and innovative nature.

Though it is difficult to send him forth after two years, we do so with excitement and enthusiasm for what lies ahead for Fr. Will as he assume the role of pastor. I look forward to what God has in store for him in this next opportunity in his priesthood to serve the people of God in Shirley and Ayer.

In Word & Deed

A popular commercial has a slogan that invites viewers to see something again for the first time. It plays on everyone's experience of noticing an aspect of something you never saw before. It does not matter how long the painting was on the wall, or how long the tree grew on the hill or how often I looked at someone's eyes, or how frequently I attended a church. When I notice a new detail, I see something again for the very first time.

The cross is a whole new experience for the early church. Once seen only as an instrument of torture and death, the cross becomes a new symbol of life, love, forgiveness and hope. Jesus reveals a new dimension of the cross through His Resurrection and no one will look at it in quite the same way. What was once

TO WALK AS ONE



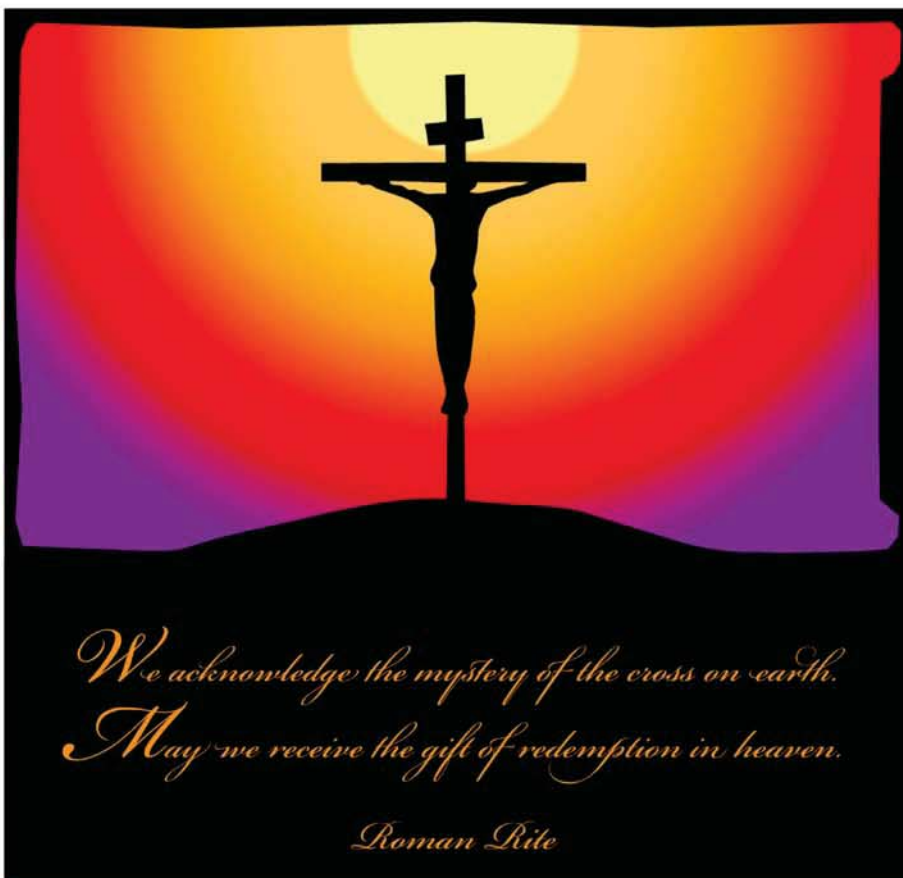
A radio show called *The Anonymous Monk* highlights the good deeds that people do for others or for the community. A random act of kindness, a planned community service or the good will of one person towards another is reported by an anonymous observer who shares the goodness of others with a radio audience. In a sea of bad news, hate and violence, it is a welcome bit of good news and hope.

The cross is an ugly symbol of violence and death. But through His Resurrection, Jesus transforms it into a sign of life. The cross becomes the ultimate triumph of life over death, of

goodness over evil. It is also a challenge to us.

When we choose faith, we carry part of the cross, and make choices every day. It is our acts of kindness, our words of encouragement and our respect of others that make the cross in our lives a sign of hope and life and truth. By repeatedly choosing to do right by others, we become witnesses to the good news that God loves us, and good will triumph and people need to have hope. Make it a point to carry the cross in your life by loving others and holding high the love God gives us to share.

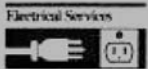
