



A note from Fr. Will,

I have never been much of a "beach" person. In my first summer as a seminarian, I was assigned to Lawrence. Halfway through the summer, the mother of the other seminarian I was assigned with died suddenly and unexpectedly, so he went home and didn't return to finish the assignment. The pastor was away a lot with his own projects. Phil had been my only companion, so the remainder of the summer I was on my own. One day, the youth group from my home parish was doing a beach trip to Nantasket beach (little did I know that seven years later I would be assigned as the priest to the parish in Hull). The drive from Lawrence to Nantasket would end up being about two and a half hours. When I texted my friend who was running the trip from my former youth group to see if I might join them, I will never forget her response, "You must be bored out of your mind if YOU are asking to come to the beach!"

I have spent just over the last five years of my life, not just on the South Shore, but on the ocean: from July of 2020-2023 in Cohasset and Hull, and then from July of 2023 until now, fortunate enough to be here in Marshfield—and not just Marshfield—Green Harbor and Brant Rock & Ocean Bluff.

The priest who was the Rector of St. John's Seminary while I was studying there is now the pastor of one of the parish's in Leominster. I had texted him that we would soon be neighbors (Leominster is the next town over even though it is in the Worcester Diocese). He congratulated me on being named a pastor and told me that he would like to take me to dinner to both celebrate and welcome me to the area. I told him I would like that and would appreciate the welcome, especially because I was totally unfamiliar with that part of the Archdiocese and the State because I had been right on the ocean for the last 5 years. He responded, "The ocean is where the rest of us go for vacation! You'll adjust just fine!"

I have thought about that a lot the last couple of weeks, and how truly blessed I have been the last five years, but especially, how truly blessed I have been the last two, to have been here—so close to what so many people only have as a destination spot, but not just the location, but to have been assigned to these two Parishes.

The other day, as I was going to lock St. Ann's, I stopped by the Sea Wall for about 15-20 minutes just as the sun was beginning to set—something I regret not taking the opportunity to have done over my last two years more often than I did. Leaning against the guardrail looking out over the ocean, what kept coming to mind is what has always been one of my favorite Scripture passages ever since High School.

From the twenty-first chapter of John, it is what Jesus says to Peter just after the three-fold question and answer, of "Do you love me?" After Peter's answer, Jesus says to him: "Amen, amen, I say to you, when you were younger, you used to dress yourself and go where you wanted; but when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go."

It sounds cliche, but the adage is proving to be quite true: for someone who, thought he did not like the beach, you truly do not know what you have until it is gone—or should I say, until you are leaving.

For many of the last eight years I cannot say that I have enjoyed being a priest (not a secret to my close friends); but thanks to you all, at least for the last two, I can say that I have—and for that, for you, in particular for Fr. Aveni, I am grateful. Being your priest with Fr. Aveni in Marshfield returned a sense of joy and happiness to my priesthood.

As you have heard me say on a few occasions now, this new assignment came as a complete surprise to me. It is not one that I was expecting, nor is it in a location that I would have ever requested. But coming at a time that I did not expect in a location that I would never have asked for, keeping John 21:18 in mind, I have to believe and trust that while God wanted me in Marshfield two years ago, while I may not wish to leave, that He now wishes me elsewhere, and so, I must allow myself to be led to somewhere that I myself would never have chosen to go.

And so, I wish to leave you with the words of someone much wiser (and holier) than I. They are the words of Dominican Friar, Fr. Jean-Baptiste Henri Lacordaire, O.P., who wrote of the priesthood in his work, "Thou art a Priest Forever." I am sure that I do not "check all of the boxes" that he lists, or at least check them well, though I have tried.

To live in the midst of the world with no desire for its pleasure...

To be a member of every family yet belonging to none...

To share all sufferings;

to penetrate all secrets;

to heal all wounds...

To daily go from men to God to offer Him their petitions...

To return from God to men to offer them His hope...

To have a heart of fire for charity and a heart of bronze for chastity...

To bless and be blest forever.

O God, what a life, and it is yours,

O Priest of Jesus Christ!

Saints Simon and Jude

isted among the Twelve Apostles in the New Testament, Simon is "the Canaanite" to Matthew and Mark and "the Zealot" to Luke; Jude is "Thaddeus" to Matthew and Mark, "Judas of James" to Luke, and "Judas, not Iscariot" to John. After Pentecost, they disappear. However, according to Eastern tradition, Simon died peacefully in Edessa, while Western tradition has him evangelizing in Egypt, then teaming up with Jude, who had been in Mesopotamia, on a mission to Persia, where they were martyred on the same day. Simon is the patron saint of tanners and lumberjacks; Jude is the patron of desperate causes, possibly because early Christians would pray to him, with a name evoking Judas Iscariot, only when all else failed.




