

Why commemorate a church dedication that happened in fourth-century Rome?

First, because St. John Lateran is no ordinary church—it's the cathedral church of the Pope and still known as "the mother of all the world's churches."

But more than that, because God has from all time intended the church building to be a symbol of His Church and our bodies. This is what the readings for today's feast invite us to consider.

God's prototype for the church is the Jerusalem Temple, described in this week's First Reading and Psalm. It's God's "holy dwelling," site of His presence in our midst, source of "living waters"—of all life and blessing. But God intended the Temple to give way to the Body of Christ. That's what our Lord's words and actions in Sunday's Gospel are intended to dramatize. Christ's Body is now the dwelling of God's "glory" among us (see John 1:14).

It's the new source of living waters (John 4:10,14; 7:37-39; 19:34), the living bread (John 6:51), the new sanctuary where people will worship in Spirit and truth (John 4:21,23). By Baptism, we are joined to His Body in the Church (see 1 Corinthians 12:13). Sunday's Epistle says the Spirit of God comes to dwell in us and makes us "God's building...the temple of God" (see also 1 Corinthians 6:9).

Jesus drove out the sellers of oxen, sheep and doves, signaling an end to the animal sacrifices that formed the worship of the old Temple. In the spiritual worship of the new Temple, we offer our bodies—our whole beings—as a living sacrifice (see Romans 12:1). Like living stones (see 1 Peter 2:5) built on the cornerstone of Christ (see Mark 12:10; Acts 4:11), together we are called to build up the new Temple of God, the Church.

As the Jerusalem Temple was, so the Church will always be under construction—until at last it is perfected in the new Jerusalem, our mother Church, come down from heaven (see Revelation 21:3,10,22; 22:1; Galatians 4:26).

Though this does not affect his assignment as deacon serving our collaborative, it will change his presence in our parishes, especially on Sundays and some weekdays at the weekday Mass. As he settles into his new career, he will be able to better determine the effects of his ministry to our parishes. I have recently been approached by other men inquiring about diaconal ministry and look forward to engaging in conversations with them. If you feel you have a call to religious life, priesthood or permanent diaconate, please contact me to discuss it further. #### Pastoral and Finance Council News Collaborative Pastoral Council

The Pastoral Council of a collaborative or parish serves as a leadership advisory council to the pastor in matters concerning pastoral life, such as liturgical scheduling, parish programing and parish life. A pastor is required to form a pastoral council, and they are required to meet on a regular basis. As an advisory council they represent the larger body of both parishes. The guidelines of Archdiocese state that a council serves a particular pastor and when his term ends so does the council. Nominated/elected members are to serve a three-year term, the pastor can also appoint additional members who have specific skills or to fully represent the parish population.

Both parishes have been blessed to have dedicated parishioners who have generously given their time and talent to the pastoral council. The council is cochaired by Jack Hanratty and Melinda Campbell. As I began as pastor, I asked the existing councils of the two separate parishes to continue as members for the first two years, forming the collaborative council. In the second year we reintroduced the three-year terms with two of members finishing their term each year. Over the past two years, Susan Galvin, Peg Scollins, Pam Hulme, Bob Counihan, and Beau Stebbins completed their terms, and Ed Neary and Casey Rein at my request switched to serve on Saint Ann by the Sea Finance Council. In the past two years we have welcomed new members Melinda Campbell, Todd Robinson, Maureen Bradley, Jane Clougherty, Jim Ellis, and Dan Hubbard.

I am personally grateful for Bill's dedicated years of service to the parish and for his council and friendship since my first term at OLA. I am happy that Bill will continue to remain an active member of OLA finance council. I have subsequently invited Bill Bowers to serve as the next Chair of the OLA Finance Council, and he has graciously accepted. Bill has been a member of the finance council for over 10 years.


