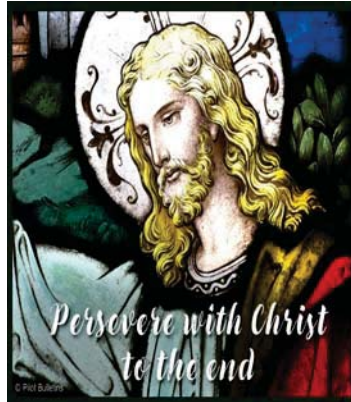

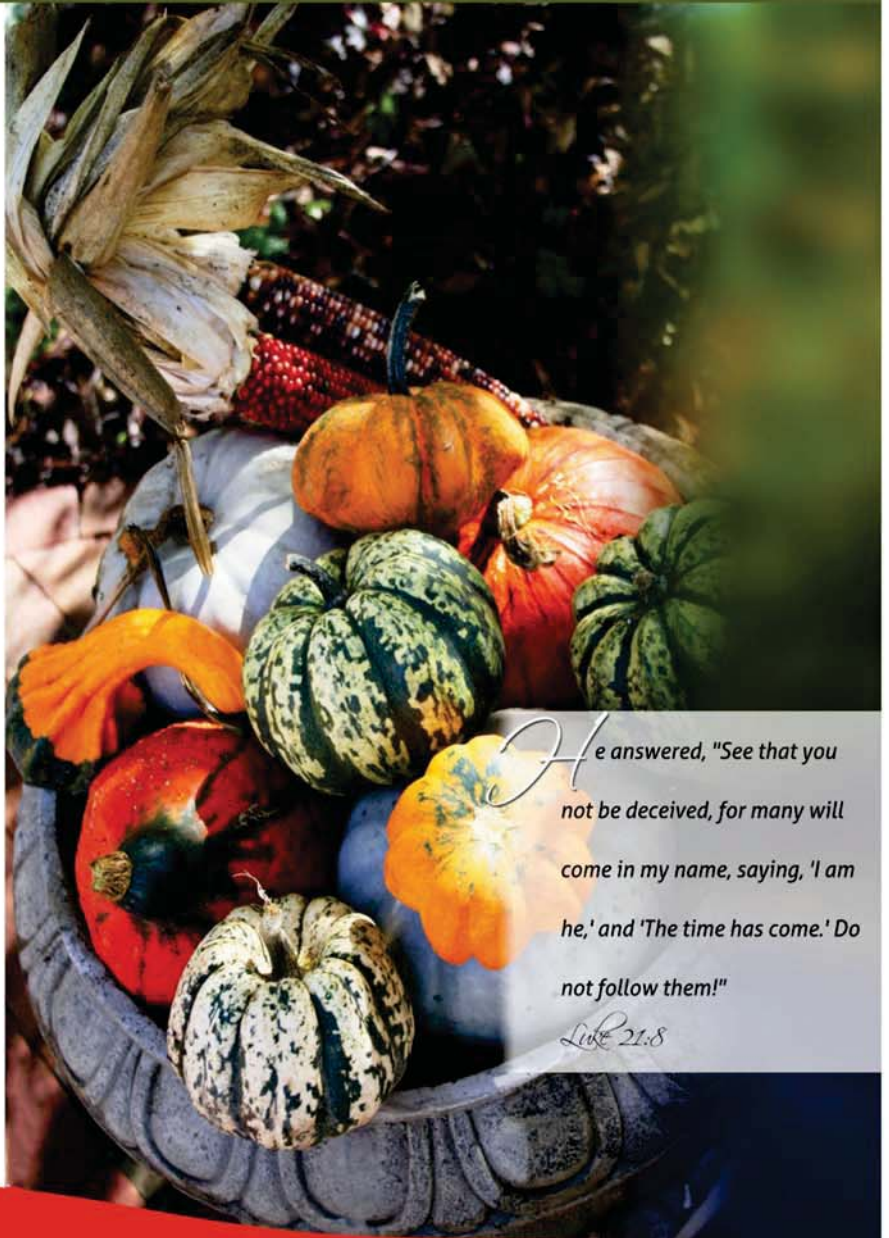

As we grow up, we all have those learning moments when things don't go so well or we experience a disappointment or rejection that brings us to tears—and usually to some adult for comfort. Is there a person alive in America who in these moments has not heard, “It’s not the end of the world”? In movies, books and our own imagination, we’ve seen the end of the world a million times. But when does the world really end?

Jesus talks about the end of the world in the Gospels. He knows the Apostles are concerned about it, but He tells them that only the Father knows the day and the hour. In Luke, He describes a scene of great struggle and chaos, events that have occurred time and again in the history of the world. There are TV evangelists who use the Book of Revelation mistakenly to describe

complains that time goes too quickly and they never get to do some of the things that are fun, that bring a family together.

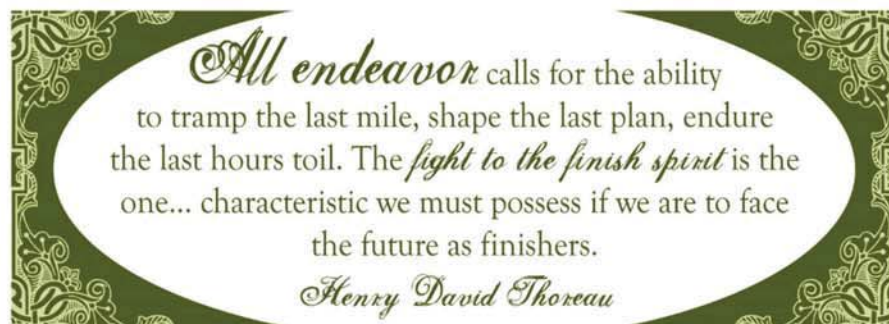
