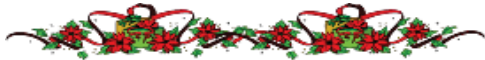

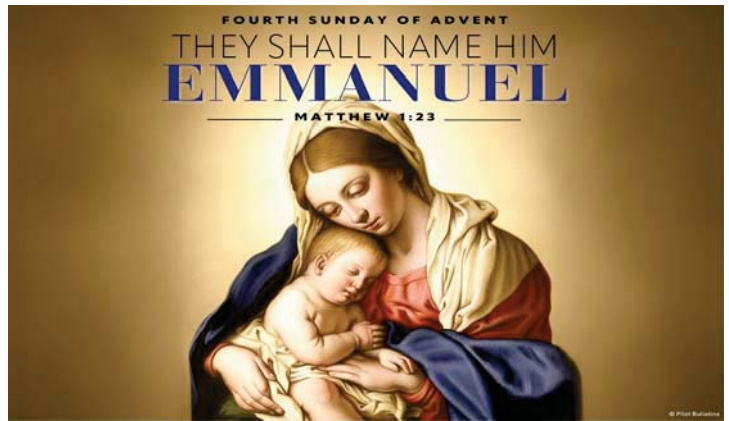

Blessed Christmas and New Year 2025

It is hard to believe that it was 60 years ago that we first heard Charlie Brown exclaim in frustration, “Isn’t there anyone who knows what Christmas is all about?” His question of course, is his response to the ridicule of his friends, for not embracing the commercial lures of Christmas. In fact, Charlie Brown knew better than most what indeed Christmas was all about, he just needed to be assured. It took the sensitive Linus to bring all of us back to the town of Bethlehem, in his reverent recitation of the Gospel’s narrative surrounding the birth of Christ.

This year, we may ask that same question as Charlie Brown, yet, like other years we come up short, or it doesn’t take root. Perhaps we are not asking the right question. The Gospel describes much more than the reason for a holiday and Holy Day in December. What does the truth that God sent his Son into our world to save us mean for us? This is a good question. How did God becoming flesh, affect our lives? Another good question. And I can assure you the answer has less to do with December 25th and more to do with every day of our life than we want to realize. We try to justify our actions by asking the rhetorical questions, “isn’t Christmas all about family” or “in the end, isn’t Christmas about the children’s joy at their gifts.” Do we ever dare to answer NO to those rhetorical questions? Those two may be ways that some celebrate Christmas, but they are surely not what Christmas is “all about.” Christmas is “all about” how the world was changed with the incarnation of Christ. Christmas is “all about” how we live our lives every day in the Light of Christ; how we see Christ in others; and how we can become closer to Christ when we have wandered. Christmas is “all about” the **Birth of Christ** – and only about the **Birth of Christ**. We may commemorate the Birth of Christ with gifts and feasts and family and friends and other traditions, but to truly celebrate Christmas, Christ needs to be more than just an invited guest for the day. Christ needs to be the Honored Guest every day. The literal meaning of the word Christmas (of English origin) is the Mass of Christ, many other languages and cultures call the holiday the birth of Christ. Whatever we call it Christ is the common and central reality of what we celebrate. Christ is what Christmas is all about! As Linus so eloquently said

“And there were in the same country shepherds, abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them! And they were so afraid. And the angel said unto them, ‘Fear not! For, behold, I bring you tidings of great joy, which shall be to all my people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ, the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you: Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.’ And suddenly, there was with the angel a multitude of the Heavenly Host praising God, and saying, ‘Glory to God in the Highest, and on Earth peace, and good will toward men.’ That’s what Christmas is all about Charlie Brown!”

May Christ, the babe of Bethlehem, continue his blessings on you at Christmas and into the new year.

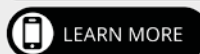

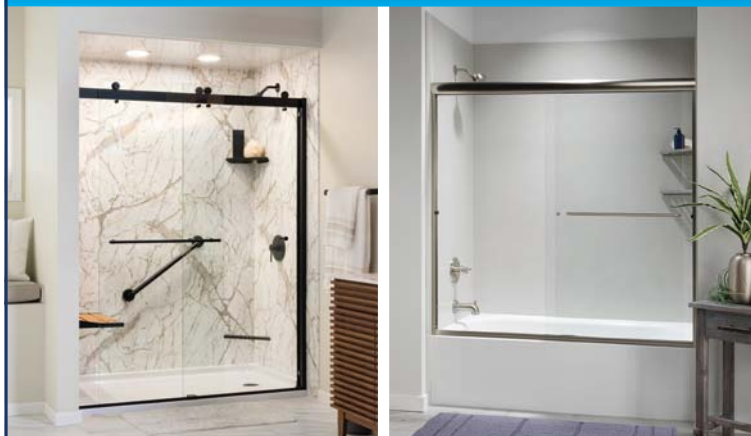
