



BAPTISM OF THE LORD

In Word & Deed

The story is told of a bearded priest who was baptizing a number of children in his large parish. Numerous siblings of the infants were talking and walking around, more interested in the stained glass windows and the back hallways of the sacristy than they were in the sacrament. At one point, a little boy finally noticed what was going on and, to everyone's delight, yelled out loud, "Look! There's Jesus giving my new brother a bath!"

Baptism should never be taken for granted. The sacrament initiates us into the community of believers, but it is the family—the domestic church—that teaches the child about God, faith, prayer, virtue and grace. After the bath of

TO WALK AS ONE

Kids are always fascinated by family history.

They want to know what their parents did as kids, where they went to school, what kind of trouble they got into, etc. When grandparents start to talk about the family in the 'old days', kids really listen. And the kid's parents can get really nervous. Old pictures and stories give children a chance to know who deceased relatives were, to appreciate the importance of their past and to preserve the stories and identities for their children too.

So why not talk about your family's

spiritual history? Looking at pictures of baptisms, First Communions, May processions, confirmations and weddings, are great ways of sharing the family's spiritual traditions, the history of your parish and the members of your family, living and deceased, who served as godparents and sponsors, who helped with building a church or volunteered at the parish school. It reminds everyone that our journey of faith is a collective one, where members of a family help each other in faith. Just as the Gospels trace the public ministry of Jesus, we can trace our history, going back generations, to those who made sure we too would follow the Lord.

A. Well, of course you're upset. It sounds like you got off on the wrong foot. You selected your baby's name very carefully, measured it against other choices, tried it out, and finally decided it was a good fit. The priest wanted a change. You'll remember that Jesus frequently evaluated a person's name and changed it, like Simon becoming Cephas, who we know as Peter. But we also know from digging around the catacombs, the Christian cemeteries of ancient Rome, that the first Christians tended to have names just like the pagans next door. By the fourth century, Christians were normally named at baptism after some martyr or a virtue. For centuries, there have been rules for children to acquire the names of saints or angels at baptism, and for centuries those rules have been ignored! Names go in and out of fashion, and we happen to be living in a period of great creativity

in naming. Very few priests will warm to names like Beelzebul, Moonbeam, or Chivas Regal, however, even if you tack a saint's name on. Nevertheless, maybe there's some room for research and negotiation. There are lots of saints with interesting names and even more interesting stories, and the gift of a heavenly patron to your child is worth considering. Tack "Drexel" or "Seton" on your child's name and you have Mother Katherine Drexel or Saint Elizabeth Seton looking on, or look to Hawaii and you have Father Damian, a paragon of compassion and humility. Whatever you decide, the true name of your child, fresh from the waters of baptism, is "Christian," a name to glory in, a name to live by. No matter what you call your child, pray that he or she will always answer to that!

baptism, the child is dressed in the robe of faith worn by those who promise to love the child and raise the child in the ways of Christ.

The Church community also has an obligation to be people of faith, witnesses to the power of Christ in daily life. If our children cannot see faith in action, the best thing about church might be the stained glass windows. Baptism is the call to live a life worthy of the saints, sharing the gift we have received.




