

## 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time


Year A

## **Lent 2026 – Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving**

Lent is a time to reflect on and reform our lives. We take on the disciplines of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving (works of charity) not for the sake of doing them, but to transform our lives. Our goal should be to emerge at Easter as people who have risen with Christ out of those things that have bound us.

**P**rayer is vital to our life in Christ, but it can be the first thing we sacrifice when our lives get busy. Prayer is expressed in many different forms, but at its core, prayer is how we live our relationship with God. The Parishes of Our Lady of the Assumption and Saint Ann by the Sea are providing ***'The Magnificat Lenten Companion'*** Lenten prayer books for you this Lent. These reflections are meant to offer a theme or focus for our daily prayer. Please take one at the door of the church as you leave today as a gift from the parish. The Holy Mass is the source and summit of our prayer. Many people add daily attendance at Mass during Lent as one of their Lenten disciplines. We are adding a 6 PM Mass on Monday Evenings beginning Monday, February 23, at Saint Ann by the Sea during Lent. We are also adding a Thursday morning 8 AM Mass during Lent at Our Lady of the Assumption. This year we are introducing Soup and Stations on Friday evenings with a simple soup and bread supper at 5 PM followed by the stations of the Cross at 6:00 PM on Friday evening. Soup and Stations will be at our Lady of the Assumption this year. Our parishes can only benefit from a strong prayerful community. Wednesday Evenings we will offer Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:30 PM ending with Benediction at 7:30 PM also at Our Lady of the Assumption. During that time, we will have confession from 6:30 to 7:30 or the last confession. We are also offering a Collaborative Mission, preached by Fr. Christopher O'Connor, Sunday March 15 at Saint Ann, Monday, March 16 at Our Lady of the Assumption, and Tuesday, March 17 at Saint Ann – all starting at 6:30, more details to follow.

**F**asting or abstaining from something as a penance is an essential universal element of an individual's Lenten discipline. This personal fasting is in addition to the two days of fasting (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) and abstaining from meat on Fridays of Lent. Fasting from certain elements of our liturgy is also characteristic of the penitential season of Lent; we do not sing or proclaim the Gloria, nor do we sing Alleluia. Music and the decor are simpler and somber. To reflect that this year in our Liturgy, we will not have a recessional hymn at the end of Mass, the priest, deacon and altar servers will leave and process in silence. In this spirit of reverence for the penitential nature of Lent, we ask the community to refrain from excessive conversation prior to our masses, to reflect a mood of reverence and prayer.

**A**lmsgiving (charitable acts) is a result of our fasting. What we save in fasting should theoretically be given in charity elsewhere. By our sacrifices, others who are less fortunate can benefit. If one gives up scratch tickets and other luxuries, we can be tempted to see that as simply money saved, the lesson learned is that with those saved resources I am able contribute more to charity. At the beginning of Lent, we are asked to discern our contribution to the Archdiocese of Boston Catholic Appeal. This year we are providing violet envelopes for a Lenten offering, as we are asking for an additional contribution to our parishes during Lent to help with our parish finances. Rice Bowls are also available, to assist Catholic Relief Services with their charity and relief work throughout the world.

Through prayer, fasting and almsgiving we, as a community, can focus our gaze on and share more deeply in the sacrifice that Christ made for us and thus appreciate even more our share in his glory.

**National Marriage Week USA**

*Let's Strengthen Marriage*

Did you know that married adults live longer lives, have better health, and greater personal happiness? Children who are raised by a married mother and father perform better in school, have fewer addictions, fewer teen pregnancies, and less trouble with the law. Research clearly shows that marriage boosts measures of human well-being for children, women, and men:

- Only 4% of homes with a married mother and father are on food stamps at any given time, while 28% of single-mother homes are on food stamps.
- 78% of married people own their own home, while only 41% of cohabitating adults do.
- Married men benefit from an average annual economic "marriage premium" of at least \$15,900 per year compared to their unmarried peers.

The seismic shift in family structure over the course of the past few decades has broadened income gaps and deepened class divides. The New York Times highlighted sociological evidence of the impact of marriage on wealth, status, health, and happiness in an important article, "Two Classes, Divided by 'I Do'". Scholars at the National Marriage Project – a nonpartisan, interdisciplinary initiative at the University of Virginia – explain marriage as a "wealth-generating institution," which is true for people of every race.


