



2nd Sunday of Lent Year A

First Reading — Genesis 12:1-4a: The LORD commands Abram to leave his homeland and go to a new land that God will show him. God promises to bless Abram and make him the father of a great nation, and Abram obeys, leaving his home as directed.

Responsorial Psalm — Psalm 33: A prayer of trust in God's mercy and justice. The psalmist praises God's works and faithfulness, and acknowledges that God protects and delivers those who fear and hope in him, ultimately putting their trust in the Lord's kindness.

Second Reading — 2 Timothy 1:8b-10: Paul encourages Timothy to join in suffering for the gospel, reminding him that God has saved and called them to a holy life, not because of their own deeds, but because of God's grace and purpose, which has now been revealed through Christ's appearance and victory over death.

Gospel — Matthew 17:1-9: Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up a mountain where he is transfigured before them, shining with a bright light, and they see Moses and Elijah talking with Jesus. A voice from heaven affirms that Jesus is God's beloved son, and the disciples are told not to speak of the event until after Jesus has risen from the dead.

Late in spring, my young nieces would stay with me for a few hours while their parents worked. I had them plant an assortment of small flowering plants.

During the summer, they often would help me water the garden and marvel at the size and beauty of the flowers that grew so quickly. By summer's end, the mature plants added beauty and grace to an otherwise barren spot.

When Jesus is transformed before the Apostles, he is not just a bright light in a dark moment. He reveals something new and as yet unseen: the glory of the Father, proclaimed in the Law and the Prophets, and now fully seen in the person of Jesus. This is God's love and mercy, promising new hope and new life to the whole world. Encouraged by their vision, the

Apostles would be the first to witness to Jesus and to the Gospel.



TO WALK AS ONE


