FAMILY LIFE:

TO WALK AS ONE

When young couples who are living together before marriage are asked why they are not yet married, they often respond with the usual mistaken notions. Money, time, work, family are offered—and blindly accepted—as valid reasons to postpone or forego marriage. Then, comes the clincher. “We want to be happy. That’s what it’s all about, right?”

No. Many people assume that the goal of marriage is to be happy, or to be in love, or to help each other fulfill their potential. Those answers might work in a movie, or on a gushy card, but in real life, and experience, the goal of marriage is unity—becoming one in body and spirit. Marriage is the joining or the union of two people (we even say that

in the ceremony, don’t we?) so that they become one.

Together, in good times and bad,

in sickness and in health, they live and love, experiencing the ups and downs of life as one. In that unity they reflect the holiness and the power of God, loving one another and creating new life together. There is no other relationship quite like it.

Unity, however, is not automatic. Good communication, shared experiences, openness and time all strengthen and nourish the bond that unites us with our spouse. A strong marriage is built upon our knowledge and acceptance of each other. We see each other at our best and at our worst, but always confident that in love we are secure. And that’s what it’s all about.
