Why Attendance Matters for Literacy

How Attendance Supports Literacy Skills

Listening & Speaking	Daily interactions improve understanding and language use.
Reading	Frequent practice with books and stories builds fluency.
Writing	Classroom writing activities help express ideas clearly.

The Impact of Missing School on Literacy

- Missing 2 days a month = Nearly 20 days a year lost!
- Gaps in learning make reading and writing harder to catch up on.
- Chronic absenteeism affects confidence and motivation.
