ABOUT

Tennessee Behavioral Health Pathways Scholarship was established in 2023 by the Tennessee General Assembly and Gov. Bill Lee. Its purpose is to address the growing demand for more behavioral health professionals within state-funded safety net agencies that serve Tennesseans with the greatest needs and the least ability to pay.

Eligible students are now able to seek tuition assistance for Spring 2024 tuition and beyond.

TO QUALIFY, YOU MUST:

- Be a Tennessee resident seeking a master's degree in counseling, psychiatric nursing, social work, psychology, or similar behavioral health profession.
- Be enrolled or enrolling in an accredited higher education institution in Tennessee.
- Commit to working at a state-funded community agency that is a TAMHO or TAADAS member for the same duration of time as the tuition assistance received. Work may be concurrent with your education or after graduation.

The scholarship is jointly administered by the Tennessee Association of Mental Health Organizations (TAMHO) and the Tennessee Association of Alcohol, Drug & other Addiction Services (TAADAS) in partnership with the Tennessee Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services.
