## OUR NEW RECYCLING PROGRAM:

### Recycling/garbage changes:

By this time everyone is well aware of changes to garbage/recycling pick-up in the City of Woodstock. These changes of course impact the way we do garbage, etc. at St. David's. We have applied (as a business) for recycling/organics pick-up.

All of our washroom garbage which is primarily paper towels can now go in the compostable bags in the green bin. If there is anyone who is not going to be using their green bins would you consider giving them to us to use? As you can imagine, one bin will not be sufficient for our needs. Let Joyce Jackson know if you have one to give to us. Our small compost bin is located under one of the sinks in the kitchen and a list will be posted with what goes in there-coffee grounds, paper towel, egg shells, etc. Recyclables can be placed in any of the blue bins- we don't have to separate plastics, and paper. Metal still has to be kept separate except for tin cans -they can still go in with all of the plastic and paper. Thanks so much for your assistance as we help to divert as much as possible from our landfill sites.


