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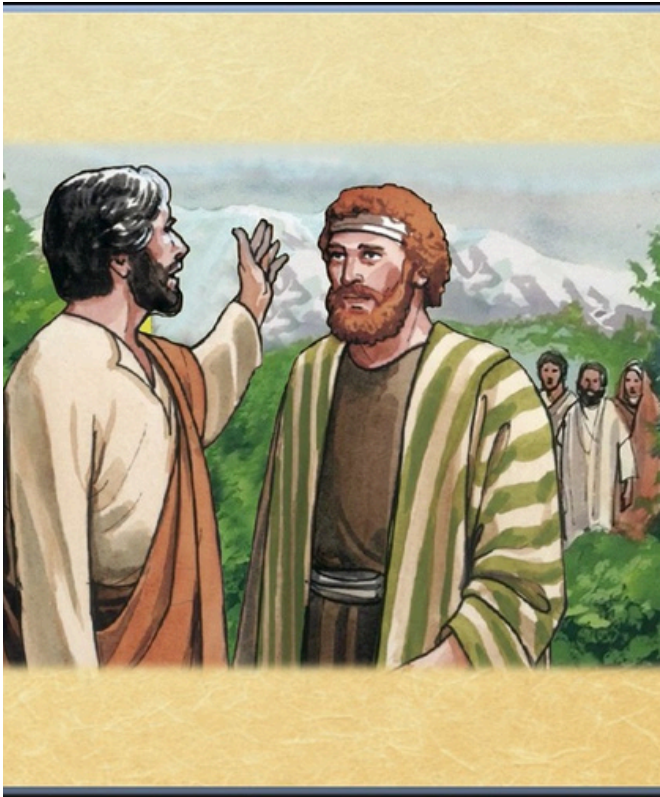

Pope Gregory I, known as Saint Gregory the Great, was a pope, reformer, and Doctor of the Church who led from 590 to 604. Born into Roman nobility, he served as prefect of Rome before becoming a monk. As pope, he reformed Church administration, expanded charity for the poor, and strengthened papal authority in Europe. He launched the Gregorian Mission to convert the Anglo-Saxons, contributed to the liturgy, promoted sacred music, and authored influential works like the Pastoral Rule and Dialogues. Remembered for humility, he called himself “servant of the servants of God.”
